EMERGENCY CROP PROTECTION CENTER

Project Purpose: To assist the Grantee to construct a Ministry of Agriculture Emergency Command Center to accommodate the Ministry's Crop Protection Unit providing them with work and office area for mapping the situation, a radio and phone communications link with the field units, a wet lab, documentation center and briefing room.

U.S. Government Contribution: This Limited Scope Grant Agreement provides \$100,000 for the construction and partial equipping and, as needed, appropriate technical assistance for the Emergency Crop Protection Center as mutually agreed upon by the Government of Botswana and USAID. In addition, the United States Government is providing an amount of \$564,587 which is being directly provided to FAO Rome for the purchase of chemicals and survey and spray flying hours for locust control in Botswana. (Together with a previous Grant announced on 23 August 1986, this brings the total AID contribution for locust control in Botswana to \$1,183,587 for 1986.)

Government of Botswana Contribution: In support of this construction, the Government will provide the land, architectural and building supervision services, a Director and complete technical and support staff for the Center's operation.

The value of the Government of Botswana's contribution for the total 1986/87 locust control activity is equivalent to \$2.7 million.

Special Provisions:

A. No more than reasonable prices will be paid for any goods or services financed in whole or in part under the Grant. Such items will be provided on a fair and, to the maximum extent practicable, on a competitive basis.

B. Goods or services financed by AID under the Grant shall have their source, origin and nationality in Botswana, the United States, or other countries in AID's Geographic Code 935.

Funds provided herein will support the construction and partial equipping, and as appropriate, technical assistance, and will be utilized as indicated in the Project Implementation Letter controlling implementation.
