Amendment No. 6 between the United States of America, acting through the Agency for International Development ("USAID") and the Republic of Malawi ("Cooperating Country").

WHEREAS, The Cooperating Country and USAID entered into a Project Grant Agreement dated August 28, 1980 and subsequently amended on December 4, 1980; December 30, 1980; March 8, 1982; December 17, 1982; and August 29, 1983, for the Polytechnic Engineering Expansion Project; and,

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to further amend the Agreement to make certain revisions in order to permit an orderly close-out of the Project;

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties hereby agree as follows:

1. In Section 3.3.(a), the Project Assistance Completion Date should read "December 31, 1989."
2. In Annex 1, the description of A.I.D.-financed inputs, Part II.A., is deleted in its entirety and the attached text is inserted in lieu therefore.
3. In Annex 1, under Part V, the Illustrative Financial Plan and Instructions (pages 7 and 8) are deleted in their entirety and the Revised Financial Plan is inserted in lieu therefore as Attachment 1 to Annex 1.

Except as amended herein, all provisions of the Agreement, as amended, remain unchanged.

Revised Section of Annex 1, Part II - Project Inputs:

"A. A.I.D.

This section describes A.I.D.'s anticipated inputs to the Project.

1. Technical Assistance

A.I.D. will finance approximately 15 person years of long-term technical assistance. The four persons comprising the technical assistance team will be instructors at the Polytechnic and will assist the Principal and the Department Heads in their review, assessment and modification of the existing curriculum, teach classes, and develop the industrial counseling program and liaise with public and private sector employers of Polytechnic graduates.

2. Training

In order to strengthen the Polytechnic's teaching capacity, A.I.D. will provide Bachelor or higher degree training in the United States for seventeen staff members.

3. Commodities

A.I.D. will provide engineering and science equipment and supplies, a computer system, audio-visual equipment, books and furnishings for the new buildings.

4. Construction

A.I.D. will finance the building of four staff houses, a science laboratory unit, a library building, including architectural and engineering services, as well as major renovation of existing structures.

5. Evaluations

A.I.D. will finance the costs of undertaking an external evaluation prior to completion of the technical assistance component."
