AMENDMENT Number 2, dated September 30, 1987, between the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, acting through the Agency for International Development ("A.I.D.") and the REPUBLIC OF THE GAMBIA ("GOTG");

WHEREAS, the REPUBLIC OF THE GAMBIA and A.I.D. entered into a Grant Agreement, dated July 31, 1986 ("Agreement"); and Amendment I of the Agreement dated June 22, 1987; and

WHEREAS, the REPUBLIC OF THE GAMBIA and A.I.D. desire to further amend the Agreement to reflect provision of additional funding and an increase in the level of training to be provided under the Agreement;

NOW THEREFORE, the parties hereto hereby agree that the Agreement shall be further amended as follows:

1. SECTION 3., AMOUNT OF AID GRANT, is amended by deleting therefrom the figures "\$886,000" and substituting in lieu thereof, the figures "\$983,000."
2. SECTION 4., GRANTEE CONTRIBUTION TO THE PROJECT, is amended by deleting the figures "\$48,000" and substituting in lieu thereof the figures "\$53,000."

3. ANNEX B SECTION 3., BUDGET, is further amended by removing therefrom Subsections 3.A through 3.E showing training levels and estimated costs and substituting therefore the following:

^{1/} The number of trainees, place of training and length of training described in the budget is illustrative. Identification of training needs, selection of participants and development of training programs will determine who, where, and how long training program will be.

^{2/} Resources for in-country training will be used to acquire the technical assistance, equipment, training materials and cover other training related costs for short term management training programs that are appropriate to conduct in-country.


- 3/ Technical assistance resources will be used for preparation of a long range (5 year) training strategy and plan, surveys to identify private sector training opportunities, survey of anglophone African training institutions, preparation of pre-departure orientation materials and other technical assistance requirements as agreed to by exchange of letters.
- 4/ GOTG contribution consists of salaries and benefits for participants. The cost of salaries and benefits paid to the participant will determine the actual amount of the contribution. In-country training facility use will be provided in kind.


Except as amended herein, the Agreement between the REPUBLIC OF THE GAMBIA and A.I.D., dated July 31, 1986, remains in full force and effect.


