1. Pursuant to the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, as amended, I hereby authorize the FHI II REDSO/WCA subproject involving planned obligations from funds appropriated for the Development Fund for Africa of not to exceed \$550,000 in grant funds over a one year period from date of authorization subject to the availability of funds in accordance with the A.I.D. OYB/allotment process, to help in financing foreign exchange and local currency costs for the project. The planned life of the project is 2 years from the date of initial obligation.
2. The project consists of two activities: regional training in family planning and reproductive health, and the provision of technical support services to the West Africa region in the development, design, implementation and monitoring of other FHI II subprojects.
3. The Agreement(s) or contracts which may be negotiated and executed by the officer(s) to whom such authority is delegated in accordance with A.I.D. regulations and Delegations of Authority shall be subject to the following essential terms and covenants and major conditions, together with such other terms and conditions as A.I.D. may deem appropriate.
 - A. Source and Origin of Commodities, Nationality of Services
 1. Commodities financed by A.I.D. under the project shall have their source and origin in the Côte d'Ivoire or in the United States except as A.I.D. may otherwise agree in writing. Except for ocean shipping, the suppliers of commodities or services shall have the Côte d'Ivoire or the United States as their place of nationality, except as A.I.D. may otherwise agree in writing.
 2. Ocean shipping financed by A.I.D. under the project shall, except as A.I.D. may otherwise agree in writing, be financed only on flag vessels of the United States.

B. Waiver

Under the authority granted to me in DOA 551, as revised, and based upon the justification set out in Attachment 5 of the Action Memorandum for this authorization, I hereby, with respect to the procurement of services provided by the advisor in Maternal and Child Health/Family Planning and the Population Advisor,

- (i) conclude that no suppliers of services from countries or areas included in the authorized geographic code are able to provide the required services;
- (ii) certify that the interests of the United States are best served by permitting the procurement of services from Free World countries other than the cooperating country and countries included in Code 941.

and therefore approve a waiver to A.I.D. Geographic Code 935.
