QUARTERLY REPORT No.4
January 1 - March 31, 1987

Two International Business Transaction seminars and four weeks of the twelve-week Development Lawyers Course constitute the first-quarter 1987 central activity. A total of five full and three partial fellowships were distributed from ANE Cooperative Agreement funds. In addition, IDLI's Board of Directors convened in March for its Fifth Annual Board Meeting at which the 1988 and 1989 program was approved.

1. Fellowships :

1987 opened with a seminar on "State-Owned Enterprises" (IBT-7E). The previous ANE report indicated that no ANE fellowships would be distributed to IBT-7E participants due to the large number of funded qualified candidates to this program. After the ANE report had been sent, an ANE fellowship was in fact allocated to an excellent candidate whose previous funding arrangements failed at a late date. Thus, Ms. Meena Habibuddin, Deputy Manager, Maruti Udyog Ltd., India attended IBT-7E as an ANE sponsored participant.

Four participants received ANE Cooperative Agreement fellowships to attend the seminar "Accords de Compensation" (IBT-8F).
