Pursuant to the authority contained in the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, as amended, the United States Agency for International Development (hereinafter referred to as "AID" or "Grantor") hereby grants to the Forum Fisheries Agency (hereinafter referred to as "FFA" or "Grantee") the sum of US\$32,000 to provide support for a program entitled "Regional Fisheries Program Development, 10th Round, Toga", as more fully described in the attachment to this Grant entitled "Program Description and Schedule".

The Grant is effective as of the date of this letter and shall apply to commitments made by the Grantee in furtherance of program objectives during the period September 1, 1986 through March 31, 1987.



PROGRAM DESCRIPTION AND SCHEDULE

A. Purpose of Grant

1. The purpose of the Grant is to provide partial support for the formulation of a regional fisheries program to serve the member countries of the South Pacific Forum Fisheries Agency.
2. AID funding will support the attendance of approximately 14 FFA member delegates at a meeting in Nuku'alofa, Tonga from on or about October 11 - 20, 1986. Included in the conference agenda are discussions pertaining to the specification and design of a regional technical assistance program to be funded by AID and others.
3. FFA will arrange for participant ticketing as well as payments for per diem and other costs.

B. Period of Grant

1. The effective date of this Grant is September 1, 1986. The expiration date of this Grant is March 21, 1987.

C. Amount of Grant and Payment

1. AID hereby obligates the amount of \$32,000 for purposes of this Grant.
2. Payment will be made to the Grantee by the USAID South Pacific Regional Development Office in the form of U.S. Treasury check(s) in accordance with procedures set forth in Attachment 2, Standard Provision 54A, Payment Periodic Advance. Payment request should be made in single copy to the Grant Officer. AID funds shall not be commingled with other Grantee owned or controlled funds. The Grantee shall deposit all AID cash advances in a separate bank account and shall make all disbursements for goods and services from this account. In acknowledging receipt of the AID grant funds, and in making a final financial report on their disposition, the Grantee shall make special note of the Standard Provision to this Grant entitled "Refunds".

FINANCIAL PLAN

The Financial Plan for this Grant is shown below. The Grantee may make necessary adjustments among line items up to a maximum of 15% each, provided that the total amount is not exceeded. For any adjustments exceeding 15%, the approval of the Grant Officer must be obtained. It is agreed that additional funds required to complete this program will be provided from other sources arranged by the Grantee, and that the Grantee will either obtain the non-AID amounts set forth for other donors, or it will provide these amounts from its own resources. Revisions to the Financial Plan shall be made in accordance with the Standard Provision of this Grant entitled "Revision of Grant Budget".

E. Reporting

The Grantee will furnish to the Grant Officer a single, final Financial Report at the conclusion of the Grant in accordance with Standard Provision 54A of this Grant. The report will detail cumulative grant expenditures, by Financial Plan line item, and will include a report of non-AID contributions. The Financial Report will be accompanied by a narrative report discussing initial findings and conclusions in regard to the potential regional fisheries development program.

F. Special Provisions

1. The Standard Provisions of the Grant consist of Attachment 2 entitled "Mandatory Standard Provisions for Non-U.S., Non-Governmental Grantees" form AID 1420-53(1-85), plus the following optional standard provisions: 54A, 54C, 54E and 54G.
2. To the extent there is any inconsistency among the various elements of the Grant, the following order of precedence shall control:
 - a. The Cover Letter
 - b. Attachment 1
 - c. Attachment 2

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3. Marking Requirements. It is AID policy that activities financed under AID-supported programs be suitably marked to identify them as supported by U.S. foreign assistance. Grantee agrees to suitably mark appropriate activities and items supported by AID under this grant. The Grantor agrees to excuse from this requirement those items which have been financed entirely, or primarily, by FFA or other non-aid donors.
