

However, proposal costs incurred in the attempt to obtain unrestricted funds are to be treated as fund raising and must be included in the organization's direct cost base. Bid and proposal costs do not include independent research and development costs which are covered by paragraph (2) below, or preaward costs covered by Attachment B, Paragraph 33, of OMB Circular A-122. (FPR 1-15.603-2)
 2. Independent research and development costs. Independent research and development is research and development conducted by an organization which is not sponsored by Federal or non-Federal grants, contracts or other agreements. Independent research and development costs must be included in the organization's direct cost base for allocation of its proportionate share of indirect costs. The costs of independent research and development, including its proportionate share of indirect cost, are unallowable under AID agreements.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

A. Purpose of Grant

The purpose of this grant is to assist TAICH to continue to operate as a center of information and to upgrade its current system so that it is more responsive to the specific and technical requirements of non-profit organizations and their socio-economic development programs.

B. Specific Objectives

To set up an automated data system which will assist TAICH in improving the quality of its ongoing publications and services and its capability to provide more rapid, comprehensive and up-to-date information.

C. Implementation

To achieve the above objectives, the Grantee shall carry out the following activities with funds provided by this Grant.

1. On-Going Activities

Specifically, TAICH will continue to seek information on the approximately 500 U.S. private non-profit organizations and their overseas programs that form a major part of its network and other newly established organizations. New services and publications will evolve as the computerized information system is implemented, tested and modified.

a. Another Directory of Organization Profiles will be produced in the first year of this grant.

b. A more comprehensive series of Country Program Reports will be published. Approximately 20 reports will be published each year. These will include updates of those previously published which are somewhat dated or of

countries in which there has been a high degree of change in agency activities. The decision on the selected countries will be made after consultation with the TAICH Advisory Committee and A.I.D.

c. The newsletter, TAICH News, will be issued quarterly to provide information on organizations and also substantive material relating to various sectors of development.

d. At least two reports on functional categories of development assistance in which the private, non-profit sector is actually engaged will be compiled, such as past documents on food production, small industry and water usage. TAICH will continue to work closely with the ACVAFS Committee on Development Assistance in developing reports from workshops.

e. An annotated list of publications received at the information center, which is of use to agencies, will be published biweekly.

f. In addition, TAICH will prepare, on the recommendation of the TAICH Advisory Committee, any special reports requested by the agencies or by A.I.D.

g. Continued attention will be paid to the distribution of publications to refine and expedite the process.

h. TAICH will continue the daily inquiry service in its present form.

i. As part of the information gathering process, professional staff will visit organizations and attend meetings to obtain current data for the system, to acquaint agencies with TAICH services and to assist them with their own information systems.

j. The TAICH Advisory Committee will be reorganized and expanded to include some non-Council agency representatives to assure a broader perspective to the Clearing House program.

k. TAICH will investigate the possibilities of increased formal collaboration with other U.S. specialized information centers. A workshop/consultation will be held in the fall of 1979 to discuss ways of meeting the information networks.

2. Automated Data System

This Grant includes the installation of a computerized information system to facilitate the storage and retrieval of information in the data base. This system will enable TAICH to provide current information with greater specificity and in a wider variety of combinations. It should also facilitate improved utilization of TAICH. A series of steps will need to be taken to make this system operational as follows:

a. Development of a Microthesaurus

The first step in computerizing the basic data services should be the creation of a microthesaurus, a detailed vocabulary list, which may be used by agencies for their own information systems and to create a more uniform method for the sharing of data. Staff will continue work on the microthesaurus. It is anticipated that the bulk of work on this in its initial stages will be done by the staff. Then, as a tentative list emerges, meetings will be held with voluntary agency people who have expertise in particular fields to try to arrive at a common agreement on terms acceptable to the users. The first phase should be completed around November 15, 1973. As the information system develops, final adjustment will be made on the microthesaurus, with the guidance of consultants, particularly on its compatibility with other information systems and the program design required for computerization.

Establishment of a Computer System

To achieve computer capability, there will be two distinct development phases.

(1) Requirements Analysis

This phase will involve a full needs analysis (two to three months) of the TAICH information system. This analysis will include an examination of the way in which the system might integrate with the A.I.D. Development Information System and possibly the utilization of the A.I.D. computer. A consultant for this phase will explore the possible transfer of the country program information from the tapes of the Olivetti S-14 word processing system. The consultant in the requirements analysis will develop the possible options, the advantages and disadvantages of different implementation plans, cost breakdowns and cost benefits analysis, time involved, general specifications for the equipment needed and will include some of the needed design features as well as a request for proposals for the program design phase.

Following the completion of the requirements analysis study, all interested parties in the ACVAFS and A.I.D. will be requested to consider the available options developed by the consultants to include costs and future directions. The decisions to be made at this time will dictate the way in which the design for the computer program will take place as well as the delineation of time frames. It is envisioned that the decision on options will take no more than one month.

(2) Program Design

A consultant will be hired for the systems design phase which will take about one month. The programming and implementation will take from

two to four months and will include development of the written program. If it is possible to put the current information from the S-14 on a computer, the conversion could take two to four weeks during this time period. An analyst will be required for preparation of material including processing of data, coding, preparing for converting, testing routines and data.

The present operators of the Olivetti S-14 word processing equipment will be trained as computer operators and could begin to input data soon after the delivery of the equipment.

The initial information to be stored in the computer would be the MATCH data base - the information on the non-profit organizations and their development assistance programs. Country program information on 55 countries is now stored on tapes for the word processing machine. The new directory containing profile information on the agencies will be ready soon to go to A.I.D. to be printed. In past years the typesetting for the directories has been done on computerized equipment. If it is this time and the directory is on computer tape, it may be possible for this to be transferred as well. The conversion problem for both the country program and profile information will be examined during the needs requirements analysis.

New information received for country reports will be added to the data base. The information will be entered into the computer using the terms from the new microthesaurus. The initial information in the computer will be updated on an on-going basis and eventually the data base will reflect the revised technology and coding. As a part of the program design, it may be possible to devise a method to ease the updating task for the agencies. Once the primary data base is in the computer, it will be possible through added access capabilities to retrieve more specific kinds of information quickly and inexpensively from any part of the data base.

c. Evaluation

As the enlarged computerized information system is developed, an evaluation method will be devised to determine the quantity of use and, if possible, the quality as based on the primary users, the kinds of information sought and any improvement in the quality of the data being supplied to the TATCH system by its participants.

A consultant/evaluator will be hired to conduct an evaluation of the new computerized system when the system is fully operational. The evaluation will assess the progress and the cost-effectiveness of the new system, including projects on computer usage and the development of any necessary modifications in the computer programming.

d. Reporting

The Grantee shall submit a semi-annual report describing actual and prospective progress and problems encountered.



28. ALTERATIONS IN STANDARD PROVISIONS

The Standard Provision of the September 1977 Edition have been changed as follows:

a. Standard Provision 7A. PAYMENT - FEDERAL RESERVE LETTER OF CREDIT (FRLC) ADVANCE

(1) Delete the applicability statement and substitute the following therefor:

(This provision is applicable when the sum of all advances under the Grantee's contracts and grants with AID exceeds \$120,000 per annum and AID has, or expects to have, a continuing relationship with the Grantee for at least a year.)

(2) Delete the term "TUS" in paras. (a), (d)(4)(A), (d)(4)(C), and (d)(5) and substitute the term "TFS" therefor.

(3) Delete the term "SER/FM" wherever it appears in para. (c) and substitute the term "the AID Controller" therefor; also delete the term "Office of Financial Management" in para. (d)(7) and substitute the term "the AID Controller" therefor.

(4) Delete the figures "\$10,000" and "\$1,000,000" in para. (a) and substitute the figures "\$5,000" and "\$5,000,000", respectively, therefor.

(5) Delete the words "less than" in para. (d)(7) and substitute the words "more than" therefor.

b. Standard Provision 7B. PAYMENT-PERIODIC ADVANCE
Delete the applicability statement and substitute the following therefor:

(This provision is applicable when (1) the sum of all advances under the Grantee's contracts and grants with AID does not exceed \$120,000 per annum, or (2) when the sum of all such advances does exceed \$120,000 per annum, but there is not a continuing relationship with the Grantee of at least one year)

c. Standard Provision 10. PROCUREMENT OF GOODS AND SERVICES UNDER \$250,000

Delete the entire provision and substitute the following therefor:

10. PROCUREMENT OF GOODS AND SERVICES UNDER \$250,000

(This provision is applicable when the total procurement element (i.e., the sum of all purchase orders and contracts for goods and services) of this Grant does not exceed \$250,000.)

(a) Ineligible Goods and Services

Under no circumstances shall the Grantee procure any of the following under this Grant:

- (1) military equipment,
- (2) surveillance equipment,
- (3) commodities and services for support of police or other law enforcement activities,
- (4) abortion equipment and services,
- (5) luxury goods and gambling equipment, or
- (6) weather modification equipment.

(For a more detailed discussion of the subject, see AID Handbook 1, Supplement B, paragraph 4D.)

If AID determines that the Grantee has procured any of the ineligible goods and services specified above under this Grant, and has received reimbursement for such purpose, the Grantee agrees to refund to AID the entire amount of the purchase.

(b) Restricted Goods

The Grantee shall not procure any of the following goods or services from a non-U.S. source (i.e., other than AID Geographic Code 000) without the prior written authorization of the Grant Officer:

- (1) agricultural commodities,
- (2) motor vehicles,
- (3) pharmaceuticals,
- (4) pesticides,
- (5) plasticizers,
- (6) used equipment, or
- (7) U.S. Government-owned excess property.

(For a detailed discussion of the subject, see AID Handbook 1, Supplement B, paragraph 4C.)

If AID determines that the Grantee has procured any of the restricted goods specified above under this Grant, without the prior written authorization of the Grant Officer, and has received reimbursement for such purpose, the Grantee agrees to refund to AID the entire amount of the purchase.

(c) Geographic Source and Order of Preference

Except as may be specifically approved or directed in advance by the Grant Officer under paragraph 10(b) above, all other goods (e.g., equipment, materials, and supplies) and services, the costs of which are to be reimbursable under this Grant and which will be financed with United States dollars, shall be purchased in and shipped from only "Special Free World" countries (i.e., AID Geographic Code 935) in accordance with the following order of preference:

- (1) the United States (AID Geographic Code 000)
- (2) "Selected Free World" countries (AID Geographic Code 941).
- (3) the cooperating country,
- (4) "Special Free World" countries (AID Geographic Code 935).

(d) Application of Order of Preference

When the Grantee procures goods and services from other than U.S. sources, under the order of preference in 10(c) above, it shall document its files to justify each such instance. The documentation shall set forth the circumstances surrounding the procurement and shall be based on one or more of the following reasons, which will be set forth in the Grantee's documentation:

- (1) the procurement was of an emergency nature, which would not allow for the delay attendant to soliciting U.S. sources,
- (2) the price differential for procurement from U.S. sources exceeded by 50% or more the delivered price from the non-U.S. source,
- (3) impelling local political considerations precluded consideration of U.S. sources,
- (4) the goods or services were not available from U.S. sources, or

(5) procurement of locally available goods or services, as opposed to procurement of U.S. goods and services, would best promote the objectives of the Foreign Assistance Program under the Grant.

1. ALLOWABLE COSTS AND PAYMENT (OTHER THAN EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS)

(This provision is applicable to other than educational institutions.)

The Grantee shall be reimbursed for costs incurred in carrying out the purposes of this Grant which are determined by the Grant Officer to be allowable in accordance with the terms of this Grant and Subpart 15.2 (Contracts with Commercial Organizations) of the Federal Procurement Regulations (41 CFR 1-15.2) in effect on the date of this Grant. Payment of allowable costs shall be in accordance with the payment provision of this Grant.

2. ACCOUNTING, RECORDS, AND AUDIT

The Grantee shall maintain books, records, documents, and other evidence in accordance with the Grantee's usual accounting procedures to sufficiently substantiate charges to the Grant. The Grantee shall preserve and make available such records for examination and audit by AID and the Comptroller General of the United States, or their authorized representatives (a) until the expiration of three years from the date of termination of the program and (b) for such longer period, if any, as is required to complete an audit and to resolve all questions concerning expenditures unless written approval has been obtained from the AID Grant Officer to dispose of the records. AID follows generally accepted auditing practices in determining that there is proper accounting and use of Grant funds. The Grantee agrees to include the requirements of this clause in any subordinate agreement hereunder.

3. REFUNDS

(a) If use of the Grant funds results in accrual of interest to the Grantee or to any other person to whom Grantee makes such funds available in carrying out the purposes of this Grant, the Grantee shall refund to AID an amount equivalent to the amount of interest accrued.

(b) Funds obligated hereunder but not disbursed to the Grantee at the time the Grant expires or is terminated, shall revert to AID, except for funds encumbered by the Grantee by a legally binding transaction applicable to this Grant. Any funds disbursed to but not expended by the Grantee at the time of expiration or termination of the Grant shall be refunded to AID.

(c) If, at an time during the life of the Grant, it is determined by AID that funds provided under the Grant have been expended for purposes not in accordance with the terms of the Grant, the Grantee shall refund such amounts to AID.

4. EQUAL OPPORTUNITY IN EMPLOYMENT

(This provision is applicable to all grantees and subgrantees who either perform work in the United States or who recruit personnel in the United States to do work abroad.)

(a) With regard to the employment of persons in the U.S. under this Grant, the Grantee agrees to take all reasonable steps to ensure equality of opportunity in its employment practices without regard to race, color or

national origin of such persons and, in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, when work funded by this Grant is performed in the U.S., no person shall, on the grounds of race, color or national origin, be excluded from participation, be denied benefits, or be subjected to discrimination. In addition, the Grantee agrees to comply, in accordance with its written assurance of compliance, with the provisions of Part 209 of Chapter II, Title 22 of the Code of Federal Regulations, entitled "Non-Discrimination in Federally Assisted Programs of the Agency for International Development - Effectuation of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964."

(b) In addition, the Grantee agrees to take all reasonable steps to ensure equality of opportunity in its employment practices without regard to sex, religion, age and handicap, in accordance with P.L. 92-261, P.L. 93-259, P.L. 93-112 and P.L. 93-508. When work funded by AID under this Grant is performed in either the U. S. or overseas no person shall, on the grounds of sex, religion, age or handicap, be excluded from participation, be denied benefits, or be subjected to discrimination.

5. NEGOTIATED OVERHEAD RATES - OTHER THAN EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS

(This provision is applicable to other than educational institutions.)

(a) Pursuant to this provision, an overhead rate shall be established for each of the Grantee's accounting periods during the term of this Grant. Pending establishment of a final rate, the parties have agreed that provisional payments on account of allowable indirect costs shall be at the rate(s), on the base(s), and for the period shown in Attachment 1 to this Grant.

(b) The Grantee, as soon as possible but not later than 90 days after the close of each of its accounting periods during the term of this Grant, shall submit to the Grant Officer with copies to the Overhead and Special Cost Branch, Special Operations Division, Office of Contract Management, AID, Washington, D.C. and to the Office of the Auditor General, AID, Washington, D.C., proposed final rate(s) for the period, together with supporting cost data. Negotiation of final overhead rates by the Grantee and the Grant Officer shall be undertaken as promptly as practicable after receipt of the Grantee's proposal.

(c) Allowability of costs and acceptability of cost allocation methods shall be determined in accordance with Subpart 1-15.2 (Contracts with Commercial Organizations) of the Federal Procurement Regulations as in effect on the date of this Grant.

(d) The results of each negotiation shall be set forth in a written overhead rate agreement executed by both parties. Such agreement shall specify (1) the agreed final rate(s). (2) the base(s) to which the rate(s) applies, and (3) the period(s) for which the rate(s) applies. The overhead rate agreement shall not change any money any ceiling, Grant obligation, or specific cost allowance or disallowance provided for in this Grant.
