Abstract

FOREWORD

The selected periodicals included in this monograph have been diligently assembled by Mr. Forrest Deseran in the course of his work on the 211(d) Project. The compilation of such material has resulted from the perusal of literature in connection with the broad topic of social aspects of water resources development and modernization, and as part of the 211(d) Institutional Grant at Colorado State University. Such a list is not only useful for future researchers at Colorado State University but for other people who within the limited resources in the Rocky Mountain area have to search hard in order to track down pertinent material. More than anything else, this bibliography contains not only titles and their availability in the major libraries in Colorado but also useful brief annotations as to the special areas of concern of key journals. Finally, Mr. Deseran has provided a particular service by concentrating on elusive material in what one may broadly refer to as the sociology of natural resources and technology assessment. Throughout this compilation a common thread unites various disciplinary areas by relating the broad themes of planning, development, and modernization.

This document is perhaps an atypical by-product of the far-reaching consequences of the 211(d) Grant. While it is not always possible to document the visible and tangible results of a given monograph, the Sociology Department as well as other social sciences

at Colorado State University have benefited in a variety of ways from the dialogue with physical scientists, from the exposure to problems of developing countries, and from the need to develop both common vocabulary and tools for addressing difficult interdisciplinary and transcultural problems. It is in this context that one has to see this particular monograph as an expression of the larger commitment of social scientists at Colorado State University to the area of natural resources and development, and as part of developing both the capability and interest in pursuing the theoretical and practical aspects of natural resources studies.

INTRODUCTION

Purpose and Scope

The purpose of this document is to provide social scientists with a reference tool for library research. Although it is envisioned that all social scientists should find this tool of value, emphasis has been placed on satisfying information requirements for those social scientists engaged in macro level research, especially in the areas of technology assessment; planning and decision-making; natural resources policy; population studies; social and economic development; and urban and regional analysis. The items included in this bibliography have been restricted to periodic type materials which are of potential value for the various areas of concern. Also, emphasis is upon American and English language periodicals although some foreign language periodicals are included. Even within these limitations it would be pretentious to claim that the document is comprehensive, for there are literally tens of thousands of periodical sources. However, the citations offered here are representative of the research materials available in the selected fields and should provide a springboard for library research efforts.

Features

Several features justify the addition of this reference tool to existing bibliographical and resource materials. First, periodicals have been organized according to major areas of academic interest, i.e., geography, law, political science, sociology, etc. This scheme facilitates location of those items pertinent to specific concerns and provides a convenient method for locating new and potentially

useful sources in a particular area. Second, items have been cross-classified when they fall into more than one area. For example, Environmental Law is found both in the Law section and the Environment and Natural Resources section. Third, and perhaps most important, a large proportion of the periodicals (over 300) have been annotated providing such information as the publisher, date started, types of materials contained, and other relevant data. Finally, library call numbers are provided for all of those items available at the Colorado State University Library. Items not available at the CSU Library are either designated as being available at a nearby library or as not being available locally.

Organization

The bibliography is divided into two major parts. Part I is comprised of a listing of periodicals according to 24 separate categories (see table of contents). Periodicals are arranged alphabetically in each category with the CSU Library call number designated in the right hand column. If a periodical is not available at the CSU Library but is available at the Colorado University (Boulder) Library, the Denver University Library, or the Denver Public Library the name of the library appears in place of the call number. For those periodicals unavailable locally, a line appears in place of the call number. An asterisk (*) before the title of an entry indicates that the item has been annotated in Part II of this document.

Part II consists of an annotated bibliography of those periodicals which, in the opinion of the compiler, merit priority of attention. Each of the over 300 periodicals that have been marked with an asterisk (*) in Part I are listed alphabetically with the following information

provided:

- (1) Periodical title, CSU call number, and number of times published per year.
- (2) Date first published.
- (3) Dates and volumes available at the CSU Library.
- (4) Publisher and address.
- (5) A brief summary of typical information and features contained in the periodical.

PART I: PERIODICALS LISTED BY CATEGORY AND CALL NUMBER**Government Periodicals**

The U.S. Government Printing Office, the largest publisher in the world, provides thousands of books, reports, periodicals, and pamphlets each year and is a tremendous source of information for nearly all fields of interest. Although only a few of the many pertinent periodical publications supplied by the U.S. Government Printing Office are offered in this document, bibliographical sources which can direct the researcher to his areas of concern are available.

The *U.S. Superintendent of Documents Monthly Catalog is the major index for government documents, including periodicals. Since government documents are organized according to issuing agencies, it is helpful to know which agencies generate the type of materials in which one is interested. For example, the U. S. Bureau of the Census publishes hundreds of reports, indexes, and papers on population related statistics and problems, while the Environmental Protection Agency produces many documents related to environmental concerns. Other bibliographical sources for governmental publications are the *Congressional Information Service Index to Publications of the U. S. and the *Guide to U.S. Government Serials and Periodicals (which is even more comprehensive than the Monthly Catalog).

"Unpublished" technical reports, although not as extensive as the government documents, provide another major source of government generated data. These reports are issued by over 225 government organizations sponsoring all types of research. *Government Reports Announcements and *Selected Water Resources Abstracts are two major sources providing bibliographic information on these reports.
