DEVELOPMENTS: The inventory is presented on data sheets which include, for each title, such information as methods of study, recommendations, and progress. The research inventory sheets are classified by these sectors: Livestock; Rainfed agriculture; Irrigated agriculture; Fisheries; Ecology and environment; Adaptive Technology; Human Resources; Health, nutrition and population; Transportation and infrastructure; Marketing, pricing and storage; and Other. Each of the project's eight publications may not contain all of these sectors. Furthermore, the inventory itself is neither complete nor final, and includes only those countries who are members of the Permanent Interstate Committee for Drought Relief.

PREFATORY NOTE

The memory for research and studies--even AID-sponsored--has been historically short-lived within the Bureau for Africa of the Agency for International Development. The newness and the immediacy of AID's significant involvement in the Sahel have left many in the Office of Sahel and Francophone West Africa Affairs without a grip on what came before and the potential value of those earlier efforts. As a result, most are either uncomfortably caught between the fear that each new research proposal or design mission may be "reinventing the wheel" or that such research is often irrelevant to development programs.

With this in mind, and the initiative of the Sahel Francophone West Africa Desk, an inventory of AID-sponsored research/studies in the Sahel has been compiled. The inventory provides brief, substantive summaries of work undertaken over the past 15 years. The purpose of the inventory is to:

- facilitate the planning and design of AID activities in the Sahel;
- identify research gaps and priorities for AID programming;
- provide an historical roster of experienced and capable research and design personnel; and
- initiate an on-going inventory of AID-funded research/studies in the Sahel

CRITERIA - What is in the Inventory?

The inventory uses a broad definition of "research" in order to catalogue the following:

- completed, current, and proposed long-term studies
- short-term feasibility studies
- project design reports
- project evaluations and reviews
- AID technical staff papers, conferences, and relevant papers
- trip reports containing substantive information

It should be noted that the inventory is limited to research activities financed by AID. In a region of Africa, where most foreign public and private financing has been French, this clearly excludes a wealth of knowledge and expertise. Moreover, the inventory does not include research undertaken in countries not members of the Permanent Interstate Committee for Drought Relief (CILSS); nor basic research on matters relevant to CILSS countries, but not undertaken in the Sahel.

FORMAT - How the data are presented:

For each proposal, study, or paper an individual data sheet has been prepared which attempts to provide the following information:

Document Title
Research Dates
Research Objectives
Method of Study
Recommendations
Progress
Contract Number
Funding (Amount)
Contracting Office
Contractor
Investigators/Team Members
Individual/Institutional Collaboration
Document Availability

In many instances, complete project and research information is not available. Incomplete files, unsystematic reporting procedures, ad hoc monitoring, etc. often seriously constrained the comprehensive and systematic collection of information on AID-sponsored research activities. Additions, revisions, and corrections are invited. They should be forwarded to the Sahel Development Program, AFR/SFWA/SDP, Room 2645 NS, Agency for International Development, Washington, D.C. 20523.

In order to facilitate use, each data sheet in the inventory is classified by relevant production and/or integrating sectors, as organized by the Club des amis du Sahel. Within each sector, the data sheets are presented chronologically from the most recent to the earliest.

The inventory is neither complete nor final. It represents only the first, preliminary results from:

- a thorough search of all relevant holdings in the A.I.D. Reference Center and the files in the Sahel Development Program Office;
- an exhaustive examination of all entries in A.I.D. RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT ABSTRACTS;
- consultations in the Bureau for Africa; the Bureau for Technical Assistance; the Office of Population, Bureau for Population and Humanitarian Assistance; and with A.I.D. contractors; and
- considerable rummaging through bookcases and files in the Bureau for Africa

In order to assure a measure of comprehensiveness and to compile the inventory as systematically as possible, data collected from the above activities have been cross-checked and compared with lists of technical service contracts and grants and contract log sheets, as well as lists of technical assistance projects and activities, by country and technical field.

As the results of additional studies and research are made known to the Sahel Development Program Office, they will be incorporated continuously within the research/studies inventory. If users know of studies not here included, the Sahel Development Project Office will greatly appreciate notices of any omissions.
