INTRODUCTION

This bibliography of the Philippine export sector contains 499 separate entries organized under seven subject headings. Emphasis has been placed on the major export industries: coconuts, sugar, wood products, and minerals. The section on minor exports deals mainly with literature on tobacco and abaca. Major statistical sources containing data on all or most of the export products are found in the last section. An author index has also been included but the entries are not annotated.

The compilation of this bibliography was largely the work of Miss Eliza B. Corcino. Substantial assistance was also received from Miss Victoria S. Esquerra, Miss Erlinda M. Sison, Miss Eilda G. Cura and Ronaldo E. Rodica.
