## INTRODUCTION

The primary purpose of this Africa Health Development Bibliography is to provide a list of key references useful for USAID to Mission staff involved in health, nutrition, and family planning program development. It is recognized that this audience may include health officers with specialized training, as well as generalist program officers unfamiliar with these subjects. Therefore, an effort has been made to emphasize basic works which do not require the reader to possess advanced expertise in public health.

Thirteen subject areas were defined for categorizing the references. Based on these categories, a panel of experts\* was asked to recommend works for inclusion, using criteria such as quality, availability and appropriateness to African health development programs. Under each of the subject headings an attempt has been made to list the entries in an approximate order of priority, using these criteria and taking into account the intended audience.

Annotations for each entry are minimal, and only used where the title is not a sufficient description of the content. In most cases, the annotation refers primarily to ease of usage.

Listed prices are the most accurate available. In some cases, as when the publisher is foreign, the price has not been available. Generally, bulk rate prices will be lower than the cited retail prices. The drafts, rewrites and manuscript documents, which are included, are available as noted. Many of the publications are available through AID, other U.S. government agencies or multinational sources.

Finally, it should be noted that these references are recommended mainly for use as general overview sources. Pursuit of more indepth, specialized knowledge (e.g. malaria control measures), is likely to require additional reading.
