

INTRODUCTION

The following bibliography of bibliographies is intended to assist in the identification of existing sources of information and research relevant to development issues in Southern Africa. It is a preliminary and selected listing of bibliographical studies, essays and information sources published between 1975 and 1978.

Primary attention has been given to listings focusing on current materials of use to present and on-going developmental research as it pertains to the region. Although extensive information on Southern Africa is available, very few bibliographical publications to date have addressed themselves to present issues and events affecting the development of this area. Hence, a number of entries have been included which cite bibliographic references appended to or included in publications, where the former appear to be particularly extensive and topical.

For additional, on-going bibliographical references, a number of periodicals are recommended: A Current Bibliography on African Affairs, published quarterly by the African Bibliographic Center; the United Nations' Monthly Bibliography: Part I - Books, Official Documents, Serials and Part II - Selected Articles; the List of Recent Periodical Articles and List of Recent Additions issued monthly by the World Bank's Joint Library; New Acquisitions of the UNECA Library in Addis Ababa; and the International African Bibliography published by Mansell in London. The bi-weekly Afriecon/SADAP Accessions Bulletin, prepared by the African Bibliographic Center for the U.S.A.I.D. Southern Africa Development Analysis Project, provides annotated bibliographical entries and information briefs on current Southern African economic and development issues. A forthcoming publication by the Center, HABARI Special Report: Who Speaks for Southern Africa? A Resource Guide to Current Materials for Study and Research, will also include a selected and annotated bibliography, and identification of key periodical and organizational sources of current information on Southern African affairs.

Southern Africa: A Select Bibliography of Bibliographies was produced for the Southern Africa Development Analysis Project under the U.S. Agency for International Development contract number AID/afr-C-1421.
