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PREFACE

Among the currently discussed and debated issues relating to the development of Third World nations, the problem of communication within and between these nations has received substantial and well-deserved attention. It is now widely recognized that an important part of a resourceful development effort is the sharing of useful experiences by people and organizations who have similar objectives and who share a common regional context. Effective communication of ideas and results among those active in the practical work of development can not only prevent duplication of effort, it may, by drawing on the relevant experience of diverse groups dealing with similar problems, lead to superior results. The promotion of such communication and interaction between people and organizations engaged in practical development work in the less developed countries is the primary objective of the series of regional directories of development organizations currently being compiled by VITA.

As an organization active in gathering and providing technical information in the interest of development, VITA views the regional directories as useful tools for development workers who wish to draw on the ideas and experiences of others in order to improve their contribution to the development process. VITA hopes that the regional directories, by providing current profiles of many development organizations, will make such access to their resources easier.

INTRODUCTION

This volume represents the African section of VITA's series of regional directories, and covers the sub-Saharan countries of Africa.

The data for this directory of African development organizations were obtained through two separate collection efforts. The first of these was a survey of African development organizations whose work included some emphasis on the development and application of small-scale, alternative or "appropriate" technologies to the problems of development. The questionnaire used for this survey is found in the index. The initial mailing, which led to the data compiled in the directory, consisted of questionnaires, of which 187 were returned completed.

The second collection effort consisted of research into African development organizations and resources generally, without an emphasis on scale or technological approach. This research utilized VITA's assembled materials on African organizations, as well as the relevant files of the U.S. Peace Corps. Rather than publishing the results of these two efforts separately, VITA felt that combining them in one volume would make for a more comprehensive directory of African organizations and a more useful tool for development workers in Africa.

The format used in this directory is designed to provide clearly and simply the essential information about each organization, including areas of interest or expertise and the kinds of services offered by each group. With this information, the user of this directory can readily identify Africa-based organizations active in a given area as a preliminary step to contacting them for assistance or cooperation. More detailed information on using the directory is given in the "Note on Use" preceding the country listings.

It is important that this directory be regarded as essentially incomplete, in need of constant update from organizations who were either omitted or inadequately described in the initial edition, or whose character has substantially changed since this edition was published. New organizations, founded since this edition was compiled, are of course also considered important for inclusion in the directory. VITA asks that any African development organizations absent from this directory or inadequately described in it provide VITA with appropriate, current information about themselves for inclusion in future editions of the directory. NOTE ON USE

The directory is arranged by country, with organizations listed alphabetically within each country section. Each organization has been assigned a Serial Number, located in the upper right hand corner of each page, for quick indexing.

The ten item format used in this directory is designed to give easy access to the most essential information about each development organization. The content of each item is explained below.

1. NAME OF ORGANIZATION: This is the name given by each organization.
2. MAILING ADDRESS: This is the mailing address given by each organization. All correspondence and inquiries should be to this address.
3. STREET ADDRESS: This is the street address given by each organization. It can be helpful in locating the offices of a given organization.
4. CONTACT: This is the title of the person to whom all correspondence and inquiries should be addressed.
5. TYPE OF ORGANIZATION: Describes the nature of each organization, whether it is a government, private, etc. operation.
6. OBJECTIVES: Notes the objectives of each organization as described by their survey response or informational literature.
7. AREAS OF ACTIVITY: Lists the areas of development work in which each organization is active. This information can help identify groups which might have valuable experience or data to share concerning a specific area of interest. The specific organizations involved in each area of activity can be found in the Subject index, under the appropriate heading.
8. SERVICES: This lists the services provided by each organization. Specific organizations providing services can be found in the Services index, under the appropriate heading.
9. PUBLICATIONS: Lists the publications or newsletters offered by each organization, their frequency, and their price.
10. COMMENTS: Describes the organization's size and organization, its market orientation, descriptions of recent projects, as well as important information not contained in any of the first nine categories.

There are three separate indexes following the country sections which are provided for the quick identification of organizations compatible to specific needs. The first is a complete alphabetical listing of all the organizations in the directory without geographical bias. The second is a subject (or area activities) index which notes broad speciality areas for all the organizations. The last index indicates services which are provided by each organization.
