PREPARATION OF THE BIBLIOGRAPHY

This bibliography was compiled to assist Peace Corps Volunteers in the Philippines and Papua New Guinez, who trained at the University of Rhode Island, Summer 1981, in locating information relevant to their work in Marine Fisheries. The selected sources emphasize practical mission-oriented information in the major subject areas important to successful fisheries development. The entries are arranged alphabetically by author within these subject categories.
