SUMMARY OF USAID FUNDING FOR CHILD SURVIVAL

*The Health Projects Database (HPD) is a comprehensive inventory of health related projects that have been funded by the U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID) since 1975. Supported by USAID's Office of Health, Bureau for Science and Technology, the HPD tracks bilateral, regional and centrally funded projects and sub-projects with a health component, including child survival, AIDS, nutrition, water supply and sanitation, and other health related activities. Projects are identified for the HPD through the annual USAID Health and Child Survival Project Questionnaire, Annual Budget Submissions (ABS), Congressional Presentations (CP), and the Activity Code/Special interest (AC/SI) System.*

*This report includes tables and graphs summarizing USAID funding for all child survival activities as recorded in the HPD, and in the AC/SI System for FY91-92. Tables 1A and 1B summarize total child survival by region and by type of intervention. The following tables, 2-7, provide regional funding summaries with distribution by funding account as well as by intervention. Graphs are included to illustrate trends and distribution. Data in these tables contain rounding errors and are not precise. Totals in conformance with USAID reporting are presented in table 1 (SR 1-91).*

*The funding amounts for FY85 or FY90 reported here are based on final fiscal year obligations reported in the CP, and on attributions to child survival interventions reported in the annual Health and Child Survival Project Questionnaires.*

*The projected levels of obligations for FY 1991 and FY 1992 are calculated from the AC/SI system maintained by the Bureau of Planning and Policy Coordination (PPC) of A.I.D. The calculations are performed by CIHI/ISTI from a subset of the AC/SI database. CIHI makes no attempt to perform quality control checks on the AC/SI data beyond those related to those calculations.*

*On tables 1-7B, other child survival includes funding attributed to child survival for the following activities: prevention of acute respiratory infections, malaria, other disease control, water supply and sanitation, health systems development and health care financing, and programs directed towards orphans, essential drugs and prosthetics.*

*Child Survival grants to Private Voluntary Organizations (PVOs) funded by the Bureau for Food for Peace and Voluntary Assistance (FVA) are allocated to the regions in which each PVO is working in FY85 through FY90 and are under "Global" in FY91 and FY92.*






