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**INFLUENZA CAMPAIGN 1991-2**  
**CENTRAL AND EASTERN EUROPE**

**I. DELIVERIES**

**A. Vaccine Delivery**

Samples of vaccine and needed documentation were distributed to program coordinators at the Bratislava meeting in September, 1991. These samples were delivered to National reference laboratories for testing prior to arrival of campaign vaccine and supplies.

Three hundred thirty thousand doses of Wyeth split vaccine , disposal needles and syringes, destructoclips, and disposal units were delivered in requested amounts (with the exception of Yugoslavia) to consignees designated by country coordinators at the September 4-6, 1991, Bratislava conference (see Influenza Coordinators Meeting Report September, 1991).

Appendix I contains shipping notifications for all deliveries. Amounts of vaccine received and dates of distribution by each country were as follows:

1. Czech Republic - 30,000 doses vaccine - received September 19 (airport), September 26 (institute storage). Delay caused by poor communication from MOH to Sanitas. National reference lab tested vaccine and released it for use October 24. Vaccine distributed to district centers October 24-25.
2. Slovak Republic - 20,000 doses vaccine - received September 22 (airport) September 23 (institute storage). Vaccine distributed to districts by October 1.
3. Hungary - 80,000 doses - received October 11 (airport) October 12 (institute storage). To be distributed with rest of national campaign supply November, 1991.
4. Romania - 50,000 doses - received October 13 (airport and institute). Supplies received October 28 (airport) November 2 (storage). Distribution began October 24 (using own supply of disposable needles and syringes) to regional epidemiological centers.
5. Poland - 100,000 doses - received September 30 (airport), October 5 (institute). Delay caused by

customs office. Vaccine has been tested by CeFarm and released for use October 31.

6. Bulgaria - 50,000 doses - received October 11 (airport) October 14 (institute storage). Supplies October 18 (airport) October 22 (institute storage).
7. Yugoslavia - no vaccine supplied this year. By the time pediatric protocols were approved (mid-Oct), Wyeth indicated there was no more vaccine available for this season.

Quality assurance surveys are included in Appendix II.

#### B. Supply Delivery

Supplies, including disposable needles and syringes, destructoclips, and needle disposers followed each shipment of vaccine. The size of these shipments led to some delays in delivery, especially in Romania where Lufthansa placed the shipment on a truck to go from Munich to Bucharest. Except for minor delays, all supplies arrived in time to be distributed with vaccine.

## II. LABORATORY TRAINING

- A. A training program in rapid cultivation and detection of influenza virus was conducted by Dr. Bela Tumova in her Prague Institute from 10/20-25. Attending the workshop were:
  1. Dr. Ildiko Kereszturi - Budapest
  2. Dr. Rositsa Kotzeva - Bulgaria
  3. Dr. Emilian-Viorel Racila - Romania
  4. Dr. Jasmina Nedeljkovic - Yugoslavia

All attenders received diagnostic kits from Behringwerke for use at their national laboratories (see Appendix III).

- B. A training program at the Center for Disease Control in Atlanta arranged by Dr. Alan Kendal and Helen Regnery is being held October 28 through November 15. Attending are:
  1. Dr. Rositsa Kotzeva
  2. Dr. Emilia Lupulescu

All arrangements and costs for the above training programs were covered by Project HOPE's regional and central offices.

## III. SURVEILLANCE ACTIVITY

As agreed upon at the Bratislava conference, Dr. Marko Kovacevic in Belgrade is continuing in his capacity as coordinator of

surveillance activities in Central and Eastern Europe. He will send weekly summary reports to Pasteur Institute and Centers for Disease Control laboratories. Dr. Ilona Straub in Budapest will serve as a backup coordinator.

#### IV. PROPOSED FOLLOW-UP MEETINGS

A. A follow-up meeting for Central and Eastern European program coordinators is proposed to be held in region at the end of March or beginning of April. The meeting agenda will include:

1. Progress reports on 1991-2 influenza campaign would be presented at this meeting (according to agreed upon format at Bratislava meeting).

2. Plans for 1992-3 campaign will be formulated.

One representative from each participating country, designated by the Minister of Health, would be invited to participate in this meeting. In addition to representatives from the Czech and Slovak Republics, Bulgaria, Hungary, Poland, Romania, and Yugoslavia, an Albanian representative would be invited to participate in the meeting. It is anticipated that representatives from the CDC would be involved in the planning and implementation of this conference.

B. It is also recommended that a representative of each country attend the "Options for the Control of Influenza" conference to be held in Jardin Alpin in September, 1992 (see Appendix IV).

This international conference is a sequel to that held in Keystone, Colorado, in 1985. Scientists actively involved in studies of influenza virus or involved in planning or executing control programs will participate in this multi-disciplinary conference. It is anticipated that attendance at this conference will help "mainstream" Central and Eastern European scientists. Several Eastern European scientists have already been invited to present papers at this conference.

#### V. PROPOSED FOLLOW-UP VISITS

It is recommended that a HOPE staff member or fellow visit participating coordinators in March of 1992 to obtain final reports on this year's campaign activities.

## VI. RECOMMENDATION AND SUMMARY

- A. That planning begin now for the 1992-3 influenza campaign.
- B. Shipment Notification and Confirmation procedures should be reviewed with country coordinators prior to next season's program.
- C. The 1991-2 follow-up meeting for campaign reporting and planning of next season's activities should be held in region in March or April 1992.
- D. That funds be made available to allow for one scientist from each participating country to attend Jardin Alpin conference in September 1992.
- E. That a HOPE staff member or fellow make follow-up visits to all participating coordinators in March 1992.
- F. That additional efforts be made to develop the influenza vaccine production capacity of the region.





Examination of the immunization activity of the Weyth vaccine.

We examined the pre and post vaccination sera of 28 patients (21 children and 7 adults) who were vaccinated by Dr. Domorazkova from the USOL control-department, using the Weyth vaccine supplied by the Hope-AID project.

Results of the haemagglutination inhibition test:

Seroconversion (4 fold increase of antibodies) demonstrated against subtype A/H1N1/ in 20 children and 6 adults.

Seroconversion (4 fold increase of antibodies) demonstrated against subtype A/H3N2/ in 17 children and 3 adults

Seroconversion (4 fold increase of antibodies) demonstrated against type B (local CSFR strain) in 17 children and 3 adults


Seroconversion (4 fold increase of antibodies) demonstrated against type B (vaccination strain) in 12 children and 2 adults

No. of days following vaccination: 20 (serum was collected from 6 children after 25 days)

Results were confirmed simultaneously by ds - ELISA.
