PREFACE

This ALLDATA Report on the country specified contains all of the most recent economic and social data available in the AID's Economic and Social Data Bank (ESDB) maintained by the Economic and Social Data Services Division, Office of Development Information and Utilization (S&T/DIU/ESDS). This information is updated and expanded at varying intervals subject to the updating schedules of the organizations from whom the data are obtained. ALLDATA Reports can be produced at any time and will always reflect the most recent data available to us.

In addition to responding to Mission requests for additional ALLDATA Reports for their own or other countries, ESDS is prepared to supply more specific data reports at any time these needs arise. An example of a more specific report might be for a listing of selected education variables for all countries within a particular geographic region, perhaps in order to carry out comparative analysis. To facilitate report requests, Data Request Forms (Yellow sheets) are included in each Report (APPENDIX A).

An extensive, non-automated "Footnotes File" is maintained on the data stored in the data bank. Copies of documentation for specific variables are available on request.

When there are no data available from one or more of the five files listed in the ESDB Data Source Files the corresponding section is omitted from the ALLDATA report. Thus, if this ALLDATA Report does not contain all five sections, it is for this reason.

Because we intend these ALLDATA reports and other specialized data reports to be useful to you we would appreciate your reaction to them. Accordingly, several USER RESPONSE FORMS (blue sheets) have been included in each ALLDATA Report (Appendix B). Every effort will be made to improve upon the Reports so that succeeding editions become progressively more useful.

We look forward to hearing from you.

ESDB DATA SOURCE FILES

The ALLDATA Report consists of five sections, corresponding to our five computerized data files:

1. The "SIDF" File: The "World Bank (IBRD) Social Data" section contains information for 1960, 1970, and most recent year. The data are obtained on tape and entered directly into the "SIDF" (Social Indicators Data File) in ESDB.
2. The "SEDBIFS" File: The "World Bank Economic and Social Data" section contains annual time series information on a wide variety of economic and social data. Major components of the national income and product accounts are included as are various government revenue and expenditure categories. Also, several "Social Indicator" variables are available disaggregated by urban-rural or male-female as appropriate. These data are obtained on tape from the IBRD and IMF and entered directly into the "SEDBIFS" (Social and Economic Data Base-International Financial Statistics) file in ESDB.
3. The "IMFTP" File: The "Selected Direction of Trade Data" section contains annual total value of exports and imports from the country specified to each of its trading partners. The data are in current US dollars and are obtained from the IMF Direction of Trade tapes. They are loaded directly into the IMFTP (International Monetary Fund Trading Partner) file in ESDB.
4. The "AID2USDA" File: The "Agricultural Sector Data" section consists of agricultural production information commodity-by-commodity gathered by the USDA. These data are gathered from a variety of sources including agricultural attaches in the embassies and are directly loaded into the "AID2USDA" file in ESDB.
5. The "ESDOFICL" File: The "Selected AID Official Data" section contains information which has been screened by Economic and Social Data Services Division staff before entry into the data bank. In some cases these data are for the same variables as data in one of the previous files. For example, population is carried both in the AID official file (ESDOFICL) and in the two World Bank files (SIDF and SEDBIFS). This duplication is in order to provide for alternate sources for the same data. In this example, the AID official population data are drawn from the Office of Population(S&T) while the World Bank population data are drawn from UN sources. Due to differences in the way the data are stored in the computer, the presentation format for the AID official data is different from the other sections.
