**SUMMARY OF USAID FUNDING  
TO PRIVATE VOLUNTARY ORGANIZATIONS (PVOs) FOR HEALTH  
INCLUDING CHILD SURVIVAL AND AIDS**

The Health Projects Database (HPD) is a comprehensive inventory of health related projects that have been funded by the U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID) since 1975. Supported by USAID's Office of Health, Bureau for Science and Technology, the HPD tracks bilateral, regional and centrally-funded projects and sub-projects with a health component, including child survival, AIDS, nutrition, water supply and sanitation, and other health related activities. Projects are identified for the HPD through the annual Health and Child Survival Questionnaire, Annual Budget Submissions (ABS), and the Congressional Presentation (CP). The HPD includes some, but not all, health and nutrition related projects funded with local currency (PL 480) or Population Account monies. Project Development and Support (PD&S) funded activities are included in the HPD when they have been identified as health related in the CP, ABS or questionnaire. Large urban water supply and sanitation projects are maintained in a separate database and are not included in the HPD.

The five tables in this report summarize USAID funding to PVOs for health and child survival activities during the period FY 1985 through FY 1988 as recorded in the HPD. The information is presented by funding account, by region, by year, by U.S. vs. host country PVO, and by source (FVA Bureau vs other USAID bureaus).

In the tables, "U.S. PVO, FVA/PVC" refers to all funds provided to private voluntary agencies (PVOs) registered in the United States by the USAID Bureau for Food for Peace and Voluntary Assistance, Office of Private and Voluntary Cooperation (FVA/PVC); "U.S. PVO, NON-FVA/PVC" refers to all USAID funding other than from FVA/PVC to U.S. registered PVOs; and "Local PVOs and NGOs" refers to all funds provided by USAID to PVOs and other non-governmental organizations (NGOs) operating in the host country but not registered in the United States. Funding to U.S. PVOs by FVA/PVC does not include FVA/PVC funding to non-PVO organizations that provide technical assistance or other support to PVOs. In Table 1 (SR 4-89), the three USAID regions (Africa, ANE and LAC) include only country specific funds; all funding which is not country-specific, including regional activities, is included in "Global Activities."

The funding amounts reported here are based on fiscal year (FY) obligations reported in the 1987-1990 CPs and on attributions to PVO activity reported in the ABSs and CPs.
