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HISTORY OF THE WEBER SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The University of Nebraska at Omaha (UNO) has a long history of involvement in Afghanistan. In 1972, UNO made a major commitment to Afghanistan with the establishment of the unique Center for Afghanistan Studies (which is the only center in the world devoted exclusively to the study of Afghanistan) and an institutional linkage with Kabul University.

During the Russo-Afghan war, UNO and the Center worked to focus worldwide attention on the tragic plight of the Afghan people and to muster support for their struggle for independence. UNO expanded its commitment to Afghanistan in 1986 by contracting with the U.S. Agency for International Development to design and implement an educational program for areas of the country which had been liberated by the Afghan Resistance. UNO staff work in Peshawar, Pakistan with the Resistance in providing material support for primary education inside Afghanistan. These efforts are designed to assist Afghans in the developing of textbooks and teaching materials, providing teacher training and supporting schools inside Afghanistan. More than 1200 schools have been established.

As young Afghans receive the basic skills of reading, writing, and arithmetic, there is hope for a new generation of children; but that hope must also extend to the university level. For that reason, and to provide the professional skills required for the reconstruction of Afghanistan, an expanded program of baccalaureate and master degree training has been implemented.

In 1989 the Chancellor of the University of Nebraska at Omaha, Del Weber, sent out letters to hundreds of colleges and universities in the United States asking these institutions to commit their assistance to help educate Afghans at their campuses. Based on their positive response, the Agency for International Development committed to providing the additional funding necessary to support this undertaking (which came to be known as the Weber Scholarship Program, in honor of Chancellor Weber). In January 1990 the first group of Weber Scholars began their studies in the United States. This program will eventually allow hundreds of Afghans to study in the United States and develop skills to be applied towards Afghan reconstruction.

NOTES ON PARTICIPATING SCHOOLS AND THE PLACEMENT PROCESS

The Weber Scholarship Program has experienced the good fortune of receiving over fifty positive responses to Chancellor Weber's initial appeal for aid in early 1989. Those schools that accepted the invitation to contribute to the redevelopment and rebuilding of Afghanistan through educational means by providing scholarship support are listed in this publication. They are a cross-section of the rich educational tapestry that we enjoy in the U.S. Represented among these institutions are the large and the small; the state-supported and the private; the urban-based and the rural-based. Some specialize in technology and some emphasize the liberal arts. Some have open admission and some have highly-competitive admission. All have come forth with the willingness to help provide financial support to a worthy Afghan scholar.

It is among the schools listed in this handbook that Weber scholars will be placed. Because there is much diversity from one institution to the next in the programs offered, and because the educational backgrounds of the students themselves represent a wide variety of academic majors, not all of the participating institutions will have appropriate programs for each scholar. Therefore, the number of schools with appropriate programs for a particular student will almost always be smaller (sometimes much smaller) than the number of total participating institutions.

There are, for example, many Weber institutions that are small, privately-funded, four-year liberal arts colleges. These schools are strong in such fields as education, social studies, business administration and computer science. Many of them are active in associate degree (two-year) programs. They do not, however, usually offer majors in such technical fields as engineering and agriculture; nor do they offer, in most cases, graduate programs. As over half of the Weber scholars to date are graduate students and/or have an academic background in one of the technical fields mentioned, they would not have been likely candidates for such schools.

Each institution, understandably, reserves the right to require that each Weber scholar seeking admission into one of their programs undergo the same scrutiny that is required of the rest of their potential students. This may be as minimal as only requiring a minimum TOEFL score or it may involve much more. Many schools have graciously waived or deferred such *de rigueur* requirements as submission of official transcripts (impossible for most Afghan students to obtain) and the requisite test scores. Other schools have chosen to waive the transcript requirement but strongly prefer that the appropriate test scores be supplied. This is especially

true of some the competitive graduate programs. Each student is evaluated individually, however, and a decision is made based on the merits of each case.

Because staying financially solvent is a challenge to all academic institutions, whether privately-funded or state supported, some schools have declined to attach specific dollar amounts to their offers of financial support, deeming it unwise to commit themselves in advance. They have, however, promised to evaluate the possibility of scholarship aid to Weber scholars under consideration of admission and are likely to grant those who meet their qualifications with a competitive financial award. It should also be noted that the volatility of financial support for a particular institution may cause it to alter, or even withdraw, from a previous financial commitment to the Weber Scholarship Program. On the other hand, however, several colleges and universities have come forth with more financial support than originally anticipated, e.g., offering two tuition scholarships instead of one. Therefore, this listing should be regarded not as an absolute document, but rather as a data base that is continually changing and growing.

Dear

Would you be interested in having an academically qualified Afghan refugee study at your institution for up to two years? Let me tell you why I believe so strongly in the need for Afghans to study in America, and how our institutions can cooperate to make it happen.

You may be aware that the University of Nebraska at Omaha (UNO) has a long-standing interest and involvement in Afghanistan--which it has maintained even during the Soviet occupation and war of the past several years. I have recently returned from a brief visit to Pakistan, where UNO staff are working with the Afghan Resistance and refugees.


The Soviet forces are scheduled to complete their pullout in February and the refugees will soon return and begin reconstruction of their country. Because of the extent of devastation, the reconstruction will be long-term and will require help from agencies and donors throughout the world. A serious constraint will be the lack of professional skills among Afghans. A generation of young people has had very limited access to education during the war. Together we can provide invaluable assistance to the reconstruction effort. Your part would be to provide a full tuition scholarship, including room and board, for one Afghan student for up to two years of study at your institution, at the junior and senior level undergraduate or Master's level.

If the above level of support is not possible, some portion of tuition, room and board would be helpful. Should you decide to participate in this program, the U.S. Agency for International Development has informally agreed to give high priority to funding of other necessary expenses such as books and travel. UNO, through its Center for Afghanistan Studies, would coordinate student selection and placement, language training, travel arrangements and U.S. orientation.

AFGHANISTAN

This sheet provides some basic information about conditions in Afghanistan and tells more of UNO's involvement.

Nine years ago the Soviet army invaded Afghanistan, annihilating or damaging 15,000 villages, displacing millions of citizens, and destroying the country's educational system. Today, there are two million internal refugees living in Afghanistan and nearly three million more in Pakistan in the world's largest refugee encampment. They are surviving on food donated by the United States and other compassionate nations, but food is not enough.

More than one million Afghan children have been denied an education as a result of the war. A generation has grown up without the opportunity to receive any type of formal or informal schooling. Efforts to "sovietize" these children have seen the transportation of thousands to the Soviet Union for intensive indoctrination, with thousands more sent for military training. The effect of such a program on the country of Afghanistan is staggering, the toll on Afghan families is heart-breaking.

Nearly 15 years ago, the University of Nebraska at Omaha made a major commitment to Afghanistan with the establishment of the unique Center for Afghanistan Studies and an institutional linkage with Kabul University. Throughout the present crisis, UNO and the Center have worked to focus worldwide attention on the atrocities committed during the Soviet incursion.

UNO expanded its commitment to Afghanistan in 1986 by contracting with the U.S. Agency for International Development to design and implement an educational program in areas of the country which have been liberated by the Afghan Resistance. UNO staff work in Peshawar, Pakistan with the Resistance in providing material support for primary education inside Afghanistan. The support includes textbooks, teaching materials, teacher training and modest teacher salaries. A total of 660 schools have been established with a goal of more than 1,200 schools to be in place within the next 18 months. In addition, some 42 Afghans with earlier professional degrees are currently attending UNO for one year, focusing their studies on reconstruction and development topics. These young persons are bright, energetic and eager to begin the monumental task of rebuilding and restoring their nation.

As young Afghans receive the basic skills of reading, writing and arithmetic, there is hope for a new generation of children, but that hope must also extend to the university level. For that reason, and to provide the professional skills required for the reconstruction of Afghanistan, an expanded program of baccalaureate and masters degree training is planned.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION

* Introduction

The Weber Scholarship Program is designed to provide advanced educational training to Afghans to enable them to better assist in the reconstruction and rebuilding of Afghanistan. It is funded through the Agency for International Development (AID) and participating colleges and universities. The University of Nebraska at Omaha (UNO) is the administrator of the program.

Weber Scholarship participants will have J-1 visas, requiring them to return to Pakistan or Afghanistan at the end of their course of study. This is in keeping with the spirit and intent of the program which is to provide Afghans with skills necessary to Afghanistan's reconstruction. Participants will not be granted refugee or any other status which will allow them to remain in the United States after their scholarships have expired.

The following guidelines apply to the financial aspects of the program:

* Tuition, Fees, Room and Board

That portion of these costs that is not contributed by the participating institution will be paid by AID. Please bill UNO for the difference. Those students who live off-campus will receive a stipend to include room and board costs.

* Miscellaneous Expenses

Scholarship participants will receive a monthly stipend large enough to cover normal out-of-pocket living expenses and other educational-related expenses such as books.

* Medical Insurance

Participants will have medical insurance through AID.

Your advanced academic training as a Weber Scholar, should you be selected, will be limited to the following area(s):

Once the academic training has begun, you will not be allowed to change to another area of study without prior permission from the Weber Scholarship Program Coordinator and appropriate personnel in USAID. This permission must be secured in writing.

Prior to beginning the advanced academic training, Weber Scholarship candidates must complete an orientation program at the University of Nebraska at Omaha. This orientation will include classes on the following topics:

- * Library, Research and Computer Skills
- * Literature and Research
- * Culture for Communication
- * American Culture in Daily Living

Classes will be held Monday through Friday and attendance is mandatory. Excuses for tardiness or absenteeism will be accepted only for extreme circumstances and at the discretion of the Head Teacher. If the candidate is aware of any circumstances that may cause him/her to be late to, or absent from class, the candidate must make every effort to contact the Head Teacher before class and discuss the situation. A warning to the candidate will be issued after one unexcused absence. After two or more unexcused absences, the candidate may be subject to expulsion from the orientation program, thereby placing continued participation as a Weber Scholar in jeopardy.

Each candidate's classroom performance and participation during the orientation will be reviewed weekly by a team of staff members from the Center for Afghanistan Studies. A candidate whose progress has not been satisfactory may not be selected to participate in subsequent advanced academic training.

At the end of the orientation period, a final evaluation of Weber Scholarship Program participants will be made. Those who have successfully completed the orientation program will then begin advanced academic training at a selected college or university in the United States in January 1990.

I agree that, as an A.I.D.-sponsored participant, I will adhere to my program, which has been requested and/or approved by my government, devote my time and attention to my studies and/or practical training, and conform to A.I.D. regulations and procedures for the duration of the training program. I agree that I will not seek extensions of my program, but will return to my country without delay upon completion of my training and endeavor to utilize the training acquired under this program for the benefit of my country. I also agree to comply with all laws, including tax laws, of the country and local jurisdiction in which my training takes place.

Furthermore, I thoroughly understand the following policies of A.I.D.:

1. Two-year Residency Requirement: I will receive and must remain on an A.I.D. J-1 visa during my training program in the United States and I will be obligated to return home immediately for a minimum of two years after the completion of my training program.

2. Dependents: Participant dependents (i.e., spouse and/or children) should not accompany or join a participant while he/she is in training in order that the successful accomplishment of training objectives is not hampered by increased problems of adjustment and added financial burdens. In any case, dependents may not join a participant until a full academic term or six months, whichever is longer, is completed. A.I.D. provides no funds for the dependents, and permission for the participant to work in the United States to support the dependents will not be given.

3. Termination of Training Program: A.I.D. reserves the right to terminate the training program of those participants who:

- a. Change their course of study without authorization.
- b. Fail in their studies.

c. Fail to carry classroom work that the training institution believes is commensurate with their ability.

d. Fail to show sufficient interest in or to pursue effectively the practical training phases of their program.

e. Conduct themselves in a manner prejudicial to the Participant Training Program or to the laws of the country of training.

f. Accept any public welfare funds.

g. Bring dependents to the country of training without prior approval.

h. Obtain employment in the United States or other country of training without prior A.I.D. approval.

i. Are diagnosed as having a mental or physical disease, disability or disorder that will unduly delay or prevent successful completion of the training program or render the participant unlikely to contribute to the home country's development for which the training was designed.

4. Motor Vehicles:

a. Agency policy prohibits ownership of a vehicle without the prior approval of my Contractor or Programming Agent.

b. If I operate a motor vehicle (owned, leased, rented or borrowed) I am personally responsible for:

(1) Obtaining all necessary personal, liability, health and accident coverage [other than the Agency's Health Coverage (HAC) Program] and licenses to meet state and local requirements for the operation of a motor vehicle. (1) A.I.D. assumes no responsibility for ex-

penses involved in my owning or operating a motor vehicle, for expenses involving litigations related to or resulting from my ownership or operation of a motor vehicle.

(2) The U.S. Government cannot provide any assistance or protection to a participant accused of violating city, county or state laws regulating motor vehicle acquisition, operation and disposition. This applies to arrest and detention as well as fines, taxes, legal fees, and lawsuits.

5. Assignment and Subrogation of Claim Payments Relative to Health and Accident Coverage (HAC) Program: I hereby assign and subrogate to A.I.D. any and all rights and claims, and any proceeds resulting from the enforcement thereof, that may accrue to my benefit against any third party, including without limitation insurance companies, for the payment of costs or expenses, including without limitation medical costs, that A.I.D. has paid or will pay on my behalf or on behalf of such third party. I also agree to execute and provide to A.I.D. any and all documents pertaining to the foregoing, including without limitation written demands for reimbursement against third parties, and to cooperate with A.I.D. in any other manner necessary to implement the foregoing assignment and subrogation.
