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TRAINING RESOURCES DIRECTORY

INTRODUCTION

This Directory of Training Resources and Programs includes information about training programs and human and material resources available in the Northwest Frontier Province. It is particularly focused on NGOs and community participation activities and programs.

The directory has been developed through the cooperation and efforts of the InterAgency Group, an informal network of NGOs, government agencies, development projects and others engaged in community participation activities within the Northwest Frontier Province. A sub-committee of the InterAgency Group designed and reviewed the questionnaire for the Survey.

Preparation of the directory was made possible through financial support from the United States Agency for International Development (USAID) through its contract with the Coverdale Organization.

This Directory is based on information obtained through a Survey of NGOs, Development Projects undertaken during the Spring, 1993. An initial questionnaire was mailed to the organizations and agencies which had been identified by the steering committee. The information provided has been entered into a data base from which this directory has been generated.

The identification of organizations, agencies and projects for inclusion in the survey and directory was based on the knowledge and recommendations of a steering committee drawn from the InterAgency Group. The primary criteria for inclusion was involvement with community participation activities or programs.

Undoubtedly some organizations and agencies have been inadvertently missed. This is regretted and can be corrected as, or if, the data base and directory are updated and reissued.

The directory is intended solely as a source of information regarding training resources and programs. The inclusion of any organization, agency or program does not imply an endorsement by

the Interagency Group, the Coverdale Organization, or the United States Agency for International Development or any other individual or group assisting with its development.

In undertaking the survey and preparing the directory, the InterAgency Group seeks to encourage and promote the sharing of information and cooperation and collaboration among the respective agencies, organizations and projects. At a minimum the directory can help the users become more aware of who is engaged in different types of training within NWFP.

This Directory consists of four parts:-

1. The 'MAIN BODY'
2. The 'LOCATION INDEX'

These components are described below.

MAIN BODY

Contents:

This part of the directory contains all of the information that we are publishing about the organizations that appear in the Directory. The entries on these organizations are arranged in alphabetical order by name. The entry for each organization starts on a separate page. Thus if the name of the organization whose entry is sought is known, it is possible to locate it without reference to the indices. It has been our effort to make the headings in the MAIN BODY self explanatory.

Relation to Indices:

The position of the organization name in the LOCATION INDEX is determined by the contents of the 'Locations' field in the first block of its MAIN BODY entry. The 'FIELD OF TRAINING INDEX' is ordered by the 'fields' appearing in the 'Fields of Training' field in the second block of the MAIN BODY entries. The ordering of the 'SECTOR INDEX' is determined by the contents of the 'Sector' field in the second block of the MAIN BODY entries

LOCATION INDEX

Format:

The ordering of this index is determined by what the responding organizations have told us about the geographical areas in which they operate. These include districts, agencies, various groupings of the above and other miscellaneous geo-political/ administrative units. The location headings are in alphabetical order. The names of the organizations appearing under the location headings are also in alphabetical order. Organizations that have not specified the 'areas' in which they operate do not appear in this index

Purpose:

The purpose of the LOCATION INDEX is to enable the user to locate the MAIN BODY entries for organizations

operating in the 'area(s)' that are of interest to the user. The user first locates the relevant location heading in the index. Since the entries in the MAIN BODY are arranged in alphabetical order by name, it is then a simple matter to locate the relevant entry for any of the organizations listed under that location heading.

Relation to MAIN BODY:

The LOCATION INDEX is derived from the 'Locations' field of the MAIN BODY entries. The occurrences of an organization name in this index is determined by the contents of the 'Locations' field of the corresponding MAIN BODY entry. Since an organization may be active in several 'areas' its name appears under each location listed in the 'Locations' field.

FIELD OF TRAINING INDEX

Format:

The ordering of this index is determined by what the responding organizations have told us about the 'fields' that they provide training in. The Field headings are in alphabetical order. The names of the organizations appearing under the Field headings are also in alphabetical order. Organizations that have not specified the 'fields' that they provide training in do not appear in this index.

Purpose:

The purpose of the FIELD OF TRAINING INDEX is to enable the user to locate the MAIN BODY entries for organizations that provide training in the 'fields' that are of interest to the user. The user first locates the relevant Field heading in the index. Since the entries in the MAIN BODY are arranged in alphabetical order by name, once that is known the relevant main body entry can easily be found.

Relation to MAIN BODY:

The FIELD OF TRAINING INDEX is derived from the 'Field of Training' field of the MAIN BODY entries. The occurrences of an organization name in this index is determined by the 'fields' listed under this title of the corresponding MAIN BODY entry. Since an organization may offer training in several 'fields' its name appears under each 'field' listed in the 'Field of Training' field of its MAIN BODY entry.

SECTOR INDEX

Format:

The ordering of this index is determined by what

the responding organizations have told us about the 'sectors' that they provide training in. The Sector headings are in alphabetical order. The names of the organizations appearing under the Sector headings are also in alphabetical order. Organizations that have not specified the 'sectors' that they provide training in do not appear in this index.

Purpose:

The purpose of the SECTOR INDEX is to enable the user to locate the MAIN BODY entries for organizations that provide training in the 'sectors' that are of interest to the user. The user first locates the relevant Sector heading in the index. Since the entries in the MAIN BODY are arranged in alphabetical order by name, once that is known the relevant main body entry can easily be found.

Relation to MAIN BODY:

The SECTOR INDEX is derived from the 'Sectors' field of the MAIN BODY entries. The occurrences of an organization name in this index is determined by the 'sectors' listed under this title of the corresponding MAIN BODY entry.
