METHODOLOGY ANNEX

OVERVIEW

These annexes provide additional information beyond the scope of the reporting provisions Congress specifies in Section 6 of PL 108-484, the Microenterprise Results and Accountability Act of 2004:

- The Methodology Annex describes the process by which USAID obtained data for the FY 2011 Annual Report to Congress.
- The Statistical Annexes that follow provide additional detail and analysis on USAID's microenterprise assistance and results in FY 2011.

Microenterprise Results Reporting (MRR) is USAID's official activity for tracking microenterprise assistance and results. MRR has prepared Annual Reports on USAID's funding patterns and institutional results since 1996.

HISTORY OF MICROENTERPRISE RESULTS REPORTING

The MRR Annual Reports are prepared in response to a body of Congressional legislation and U.S. government initiatives that testify to the U.S. government's longstanding and strong commitment to effective and targeted microenterprise development. The FY 2011 MRR Annual Report fulfills the provision in Section 6 of PL 108-484, the Microenterprise

Results and Accountability Act of 2004, that USAID will submit an annual report on the implementation of 12 reporting requirements.

The Microenterprise Initiative, launched in 1994 and renewed in 1997, articulated USAID's basic commitment and strategy for support to microenterprise development. The Microenterprise for Self-Reliance and International Anti-Corruption Act of 2000 authorized \$155 million in fiscal years 2001 and 2002 for USAID microenterprise development programs, and designated that 50 percent of USAID microenterprise funding should benefit the very poor.

The Amendment to the Microenterprise for Self-Reliance and International Anti-Corruption Act of 2000, which became public law in 2003, authorized \$175 million in FY 2003 and \$200 million in FY 2004 for USAID microenterprise development programs, while maintaining the target that 50 percent of all microenterprise funds benefit the poor. The Amendment also required that USAID and its partners develop and use poverty measurement tools to assess the poverty level of microenterprise clients. By the end of FY 2011, USAID had developed and certified Poverty Assessment Tools (PATs) for 38 countries.

The U.S. Congress did not establish a new earmark for microenterprise funding for FY 2011, so USAID operated under the earmark of \$265 million that was established by the

Consolidated Appropriations Act for the FY 2010 reporting period.

DATA COLLECTION OVERVIEW

The MRR database is a password-enabled "live" system that contains two types of data:

- 1) Funding data, provided by USAID field Missions and central offices; and
- 2) Project results, provided by USAID's implementing partners.

Each year, MRR contacts USAID Missions and requests that they provide information through the online database on funding levels of USAID microenterprise-related activities for the most recently completed fiscal year (e.g., for this year's MRR reporting cycle, Missions were required to provide information for the reporting period 10/1/2010 – 9/30/2011). Specific information in this regard includes: (microenterprise allocation amounts), funding account (e.g., Development Assistance, Economic Support Funds),¹ and funding amounts obligated to recipient institutions with agreement/contract numbers (if available), as well as current institution contact information. Based on the information provided by the USAID operating units, MRR assigns results-level surveys to the identified implementing

partners. Since the MRR data collection cycle is annual and may occasionally survey partners shortly after their funding agreements are in place, USAID does not view results collected in given year as directly linked to funds obligated that year. Rather, questionnaire results present a snapshot of USAID's implementing partners at different points in their funding cycle, which may run anywhere from one to five years.

FUNDING DATA: USAID MISSIONS AND OPERATING UNITS

USAID Missions report microenterprise development funding to MRR when it is clearly determined that the ultimate beneficiaries are microenterprises—defined by USAID as enterprises owned and operated by poor or low-income people, with 10 or fewer employees (including unpaid family members). In FY 2008, this definition was amended to include crop production activities that also meet the other criteria mentioned above.

MRR instructs USAID field missions and offices to report only on the portions of obligations that directly benefit microenterprises. In cases where a project's beneficiaries are not all at the micro-level (i.e. they include small and medium enterprises for example), or where microenterprise is a component of a broader program, such as food security, health, or education, USAID Missions will prorate the level of funding that is relevant

only to microenterprise when reporting to MRR.

Staff from USAID/Washington's Microenterprise & Private Enterprise Promotion office (MPEP) as well as MRR staff, review the funding data provided by field missions. This data is subject to change and is adjusted as often as necessary in the online database.

Normally, MRR finalizes the tally for obligations made during a fiscal year soon after the end of the calendar year. In FY 2011, the mission obligation data was collected and verified primarily between November 2011 and March 2012.

FUNDING DATA: PARTNER INSTITUTIONS

Based on the information provided by the USAID operating units, MRR assigns results-level surveys to the identified implementing partners. MRR surveys partners with agreements that continue to be active in the current reporting fiscal year and that have received funding in the past three fiscal years (including the fiscal year in question).

For the FY 2011 Annual Report, MRR included implementing partners that received funding for microenterprise programming/projects in FY 09, in FY 10 and/or 11.

MRR obtains data directly from the implementing partner organizations. In FY 2009, MRR began collecting data on specific sub-obligation amounts provided by primary recipients of USAID funds to their sub-recipients through grants-under-contract. This allows USAID to report all amounts of funds obligated through grants and cooperative agreements, including funds to contractors that are sub-allocated through sub-grant mechanisms.

In some instances, a partner is unable to access or complete the MRR questionnaires online and may request a Word version to be delivered via email. In this case, MRR staff manually enters the data from the Word version of the questionnaire into the database on behalf of the reporting partner institution. The USAID operating unit overseeing the funding mechanism (usually a grant or contract) may assist in contacting and following up with partners if necessary.

Viewing their data from prior years online often helps institutions ensure consistency of reporting from year to year. This feature was developed for the FY 2010 reporting period.

MRR conducts a thorough data cleaning and verification process to review data for anomalies, data entry errors, and omissions. Microenterprise experts within USAID also scan the data for anomalies.

MRR SURVEY:

For FY 2011, MRR consolidated the four previous partner survey types (Enterprise Development, Microfinance, Policy/Enabling Environment, and Poverty Assessment Tool) into one partner level survey. To minimize the reporting burden on partners, remove duplication across questionnaires, and synch MRR with USAID's current, more integrated programming approach, the MRR team developed a new partner survey model whereby all partners receive one questionnaire with a built-in logic matrix presenting sets of sub-questions based on reporters' responses.

MRR continues to collect microfinance results on certain standard performance indicators for MFIs, including number of borrowers and savers disaggregated by rural, gender and those with disabilities, degree of operational and financial self-sufficiency.

MRR also collects data on microenterprises accessing non-financial services, including agricultural cooperatives and small holder farmers. Much of USAID's investments in microenterprise are through value chain development (both agricultural and non-agricultural) and enterprise development activities.

The MRR survey continues to collect information on policy advocacy or enabling

environment activities. The enabling environment for microenterprises includes appropriate legal, regulatory, and supervisory practices for both public and private microfinance institutions. It also includes the policy, regulations, and administrative practices governing the business environment in which microenterprises operate.

Finally, MRR collects data on Poverty Assessment Tool (PAT) implementation and results. It is through MRR that partners submit PAT implementation results to USAID and ultimately to Congress. All USAID projects and partner organizations receiving at least US\$100,000 from USAID in a fiscal year for microenterprise activities in countries with a USAID-approved tool are required to report. To identify partners who received this significant amount of funding, USAID presumes that any implementing partner, in a country with a USAID-approved tool, that spent at least \$100,000 in obligations to support microenterprise development in the previous fiscal year will need to report using the tool, as will any partner with at least \$100,000 in projected obligations for the current fiscal year. All funding accounts with microenterprise activities undertaken as part of broader programs count toward this total, including PEPFAR, ACI, and Title II. By the end of FY 2011, USAID had certified Poverty Assessment Tools for 38 countries.

The FY 2011 questionnaire is reproduced at the end of the Methodology Annex. The Statistical Annexes that follow present the collected data – which are also summarized in the MRR Annual Report to Congress, Fiscal Year 2011.

RESPONSE RATE

The total number of questionnaires assigned to USAID implementing partners for the FY 2011 annual report was 230. MRR received responses on 186 questionnaires — an 81 percent response rate. This figure includes respondents who provided data as well as those who indicated “no data to report.”

In the case of the latter, valid reasons for partner institutions with no data to report include: new activities for which data is not yet available; activities for which there is no related client data, (such as the MRR project itself); activities that ended prior to the start of the reporting fiscal year and are therefore not eligible to be surveyed; activities that ended prior to the MRR's data collection period and whose knowledgeable project personnel are no longer on hand to report data.

Table below shows the 186 respondents to USAID's FY 2011 questionnaires by partner institution type.

FUNDS BENEFITING THE VERY POOR

The Microenterprise for Self-Reliance and International Anti-Corruption Act of 2000 mandated that half of all USAID microenterprise funds benefit the very poor, defined as the bottom (poorest) 50 percent of people living below their country's poverty line. The 2000 Act was amended in 2003 to add a second definition of the very poor, i.e., those

living on less than \$1 a day at purchasing power parity (PPP).² The 2003 Amendment also

² "\$1 a day at PPP" refers to the local equivalent of one U.S. dollar when converted using the purchasing power parity exchange rate, which equalizes the overall purchasing power of different currencies. required USAID to develop and certify at least two tools for assessing the poverty level of its microenterprise beneficiaries.

FY 2011 was the fifth year that USAID used the Poverty Assessment Tool (PAT) for measuring client poverty levels.

POVERTY ASSESSMENT TOOLS

Through early development and testing of two new poverty assessment tools, as mandated by Congress, USAID determined that achieving reasonable accuracy in measuring poverty would require that individual PATs be developed and tested on a country-by-country basis, using country-specific data.³ In developing PATs, USAID has prioritized those countries with the highest levels of USAID microenterprise funding and those countries with available recent household survey data.⁴

As of FY 2011, USAID had developed and certified PATs for 38 countries: Albania, Azerbaijan, Bangladesh, Bolivia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Cambodia, Colombia, Timor-Leste, Ecuador, El Salvador, Ethiopia, Ghana, Guatemala, Haiti, India, Indonesia, Jamaica, Kazakhstan, Kenya, Kosovo, Liberia, Madagascar, Malawi, Mexico, Nepal, Nicaragua, Nigeria, Paraguay, Peru, the Philippines, Rwanda, Senegal, Serbia, Tajikistan, Tanzania, Uganda, Vietnam, and West Bank.

METHODOLOGY FOR CALCULATING FUNDS BENEFITING THE VERY POOR⁵

Eight partner institutions in eight countries reported on PAT results in FY 2011. By weighting and applying this year's reported PAT data against the overall FY 2011 portfolio, USAID estimates that 38 percent of the reported \$286 million in funds for microenterprise benefited the very poor in FY 2011. To calculate the overall FVP percent using the PAT data, MRR takes the following steps:

1. MRR calculates the total amount of USAID funding obligated in FY 2011 (or the most recent fiscal year if no FY 2011 funds were reported) that is associated with partners who reported FY 11 PAT results. Each partner's share is then divided by the total as a means of determining each partner's weight in the FVP calculation.
2. The weighted obligation percentages for each partner record are multiplied by the percent of very poor beneficiaries reported by each partner. This provides a weighted percent FVP calculation for each record.

3. The individual percentages for all records are summed to provide a total estimated percent FVP.

COST EFFECTIVENESS

Reporting requirement four within the Microenterprise Results and Accountability Act (MRAA) of 2004 calls for an "analysis of the comparative cost-effectiveness and sustainability of projects carried out under these mechanisms", (contracts, grants and cooperative agreements).

METHODOLOGY FOR CALCULATING COST EFFECTIVENESS

One measure of the cost-effectiveness and sustainability of microenterprise programming is the sustainability of partner institutions in implementing microfinance programs. The partner institutions report on the number of MFIs that have reached operational and financial sustainability, through which MRR calculates the overall percentage of partner MFIs that are financially and operationally sustainable.

To look at cost effectiveness, MRR also analyzes the cost per microenterprise

participant by Technical Activity Type⁶. MRR's cost-effectiveness analysis is based on funds reported to MRR by USAID Missions for FY 2011, which include project-obligated funds to support microenterprise-related activities in the given fiscal year. The participant-level data is based on FY 2011 microenterprise related results reported to MRR by USAID's implementing partners identified by USAID Missions in their funding reporting. Cost per participant is calculated by dividing the sum of funding obligations reported to MRR (for all active years per project included in a given cluster) by the total numbers of participants reported in a given cluster - which includes microenterprise owners, microenterprise employees, savers and borrowers.

To ascertain cost per microenterprise participant, the analysis clusters programs into one of seven groups, each representing a different mix of Technical Activity Type(s).

MRR first considers programs that pursue a single technical activity type. Of the total, only twenty projects pursued a single technical activity type. Cost per participant of programs in the microfinance activity type was \$39,

economic strengthening activity types was \$209, and Rural and Agriculture Value Chain Development was \$166.

MRR also considers four program cluster areas: **Rural Clusters** (typically grouping Rural and Agricultural Value Chain Development, Economic Strengthening and possibly another Activity Type), **SME Clusters** (often combining SME Services, Non-Agricultural Value Chain Development and Enabling Environment), and **Mobile Clusters** (often combining Mobile Financial Services and Microfinance). Cost per participant of these clusters varied somewhat significantly, with the Mobile Cluster averaging \$8 per microenterprise participant and the SME Cluster averaging \$2,888 per microenterprise participant. **Multi-sector Clusters**⁷ are those programs that include all or nearly all of the Activity Types. Fourteen programs demonstrated this highly diversified strategy. Cost per microenterprise participant for these programs was \$108 which is substantially below \$162 as the cost per participant for the total

“Other”⁸ programs that fell outside the defined clusters.

There was no consistent trend in the cost-effectiveness of projects carried out under contracts versus grants or cooperative agreements.
