Abstracts on reproductive health, population, family planning, and related health issues.

Leading full-text scientific database offering journal articles and book chapters from over 2,500 peer-reviewed journals and more than 11,000 books.

### **Web of Science**

Multidisciplinary citation index that allows researchers to determine who has cited whom, to track citations, and to find articles that share many references in common.
