Project Objective and Description:

The purpose of this project is to assist selected State Councils and State Secretaries of Education in planning and implementing secondary education programs and to train a Corp of Brazilian secondary education planners and key personnel. To assist Brazil establish, operate and maintain four technical Area Training Centers; to assist the National Apprenticeship Service; to assist the Ministry of Education improve its industrial vocational training programs; to assist the Ministry of Education improve its national industrial apprenticeship training at Senai in the Northeast; to assist the Ministry of Education improve, strengthen, and reform their programs of secondary school teacher training; and assist in the improvement of Commercial Education.

Progress to Date:

Recruitment is underway for a secondary education advisor and also a contract team to work with the Consultant Services. About 75 percent of \$453,000 worth of industrial commodities have been delivered. About 40% of the necessary participant training has been completed in vocational training. All 4% of the Area Technical Centers are in process of being established. A pilot program in industrial arts instruction is being carried out in the state of Goias for the past year. Eight participants in industrial education administration has been selected for training in the U.S.
