In view of the accelerated implementation of the rural nutrition intervention in Bandundu Region and the emergency nutrition intervention in Bas Zaire Region, the current contract, AID/afr-C-1378, with Tulane University should be amended as follows:

Article I, Section A - Objective

Amend opening paragraph to read "twenty-seven" months in both instances where it now reads "twenty-four months".

Delete "of two years" from Item 6.

Add an Item 7 as follows: "A special survey will be carried out in western Bas Zaire Region as outlined in Article I.B.3a."

Article I, Section B - Description of Services

Add to the first paragraph of Item 1 "A third area shall be in Bas Zaire where there is reported severe malnutrition secondary to prolonged drought."

Add an Item 3.a. as follows: "In Bas Zaire the Contractor will perform an evaluation to determine causes, severity and type of malnutrition present. The findings will be reported along with specific recommendations for relief. Follow-up studies will be conducted by the Contractor and further recommendations made after interventions are underway. The Contractor will not, however, be responsible for the implementation of the interventions."

Amend the critical targets listed in Item 5 to read as follows:

January 15, 1978 - Contractor's first technician arrives in-country

April 15, 1978 - Preliminary field site surveys complete and sites selected in Kinshasa, as well as in rural Bandundu Region. Inception Report completed, including plan of action for first 24 months of project activities.

August 15, 1978 - Field team of auxiliary nurses hired and trained. Data collection started in urban zones.

November 15, 1978 - Field team trained and data collection started in Bandundu Region rural zone.

December 31, 1978 - Collection of data in Bas Zaire rural zones complete, along with analysis and recommendations for emergency interventions.

May 15, 1979 - Nutrition intervention started in urban zones.

July 15, 1979 - Nutrition intervention started in Bandundu Region rural zone.

September 15, 1979 - Preliminary evaluation of progress in urban zones complete and necessary changes effected.

February 15, 1980 - Overall evaluation of progress during first 26 months of Project completed (participation by Contractor, GOZ and USAID/Zaire).

Amend Item 6 to increase consultant services by 15 man-months from a total of 25 to a new total of 40 man-months for the 27-month life of the contract. This increase of 15 man-months includes the three man-months required for the Bas-Zaire emergency survey and follow-up. These services are arranged by Tulane University and may be provided by members of the Tulane staff or by experts recruited from outside the University. Costs vary accordingly.

Add an Item 8 to Article I.B. as follows: "Tulane University is authorized to purchase miscellaneous small items for the Project not to exceed a total of \$20,000. These items may include laboratory supplies and equipment, computer software supplies, etc. No single item shall cost more than \$2,500."

Article I - Section C, Report Requirements

Amend the list of reports to read as follows:

- (1) Inception Report (April 15, 1978)
- (2) Training Program Plan (October 1978)
- (3) Assessment of malnutrition problem in Bas Zaire and recommendations for action (December 1978)
- (4) Assessment of nutrition factors in Kinshasa zones and recommendations for interventions (May 1979)
- (5) Assessment of nutrition factors in Popokabaka and recommendations for intervention (September 1979)
- (6) Preliminary evaluation of interventions in Kinshasa Zone and recommendations (September 1979)
- (7) Joint overall evaluation report (March 1980)

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Article III - Period of Contract Services and Duty Post.

Amend Section A to read "Total AID dollar funds previously made available for payment and allotted to this Contract. See the clause of the General Provisions entitled Limitation of Funds and the article of the Schedule entitled Budget if applicable. \$582,850"

Amend Section B to read "Additional funds made available for payment and allotted to this Contract under the current Amendment. See the clause of the General Provisions entitled Limitation of Funds and the article of the Schedule entitled Budget if applicable. This sum includes the \$27,768 cited in Article IV, Section B of the original contract. \$230,000"

Total Estimated Contract Cost \$812,850

Article V - Budget

This PIO/T provides an increase of \$230,000 for Contract Services. Of this amount \$27,768 completes the funding for services as described in the original contract signed in November 1977. The balance of \$202,232 is provided to finance the additional services requested in the current contract amendment. Briefly, these are:

1. A three-month extension of the Contract itself including the services of the resident advisors, Dr. Franklin and Dr. Rico-Velasco, and the backstopping services of Tulane University.
2. Fifteen additional man-months of consultant services.
3. A line item of \$20,000 for commodities

These increases in service will result in increases in Item A, Cost Line of Article V. Mission requests that AID/W negotiate the increase required for each line item with Tulane University. The total contract funding under the amended contract shall not exceed \$812,850.
