A. Objective for which the Technical Services are to be Used - To prepare a study of factors affecting the tourism industry in the Central African Republic, Chad, Gabon, and the Cameroon and prepare a separate report for each recommending a strategy for the development of tourism in each of the respective countries.

1. The consultant will advise each Government on the possibility of tourism as an "indivisible" export which can possibly play a significant role in earning foreign exchange and recommend a strategy for developing tourism in their countries.

2. In the course of this assignment the consultant will:

(a) Evaluate and briefly describe:

- (1) Geographical and climatic features of each country
- (2) Present and potential tourist attractions (beaches, game reserves, etc.)
- (3) Adequacy of existing facilities including:
 - a. Hotels (no. of rooms, prices, staffing)
 - b. Restaurants (domestic and imported food supplies included)
 - c. Local transport
 - d. International Airline service
 - e. Tourist promotion at home and abroad.
