(ASPAU) 698-11-660-603

In the light of our recent conversations concerning AAI, I feel it necessary to attach this memorandum of further explanation relating to my belief that we should approve the Junior Year Transfers Program outlined in the attached PROP amendment. The total annual cost of this program of \$90,000 a year is not great enough for you to retract the letter of October 5, 1970 which you sent to Mr. Neilson stating we would undertake this program. I, therefore, do not believe we have any alternative but to proceed with this new AAI element, albeit at a much lower level than AAI has requested.

The approval of this PROP amendment should in no way deter us from conducting, on an urgent basis, a new budget review of the total AAI, and OLC programs.

The evaluation is to be limited to the provision of information directly related to the value of these programs to the participating African countries with particular reference to their manpower needs, priority economic and social development fields, the student rate of return to their home countries, their employment after training in relation to their schooling, and the receptivity of both the participating countries and students to the latter's training in the United States (insofar as ASPAU/AFGRAD are concerned), and in other African countries (INTERAF). No effort should be expended to include comparability studies of other U.S., A.I.D. or third country training programs similar in nature to those evaluated unless they have had a direct and negative effect upon the ASPAU/AFGRAD/INTERAF programs. the economic and social development of their countries. A description of the programs and their major objectives follows:

ASPAU

The African Scholarship Program of American Universities (ASPAU) was begun in 1961 as a cooperative venture of A.I.D., American universities and African governments. It is an undergraduate program for African students selected by the participating African government primarily directed at relieving the urgent needs for trained manpower in top and middle level positions important to the economic and social development of their countries.

AFGRAD

The African Graduate Fellowship Program (AFGRAD) was begun in 1963 as a supplement to the ASPAU program to provide graduate level training in American universities for selected African students in fields of study related to specific economic and social development activities, when such training is not available in Africa.

INTERAF

The Inter-African Scholarship Program (INTERAF) was started in 1967 with the gradual expansion of university facilities and programs in Africa. The purpose of this program is to enable African students to attend African universities in countries other than their own when specialized training is not available in their own countries. It was anticipated that this program would gradually replace the ASPAU program, and that African training for Africans would be more relevant than comparable training in the United States.

INTERAF - Analysis of records at the Association of African Universities (AAU) in Accra, Ghana, and interviews with: 1) African students and initial graduates (class of 1972); 2) African education officials in the participating countries; 3) AAU Board members and officers; 4) African manpower boards or committees in terms of occupational priorities and needs; 5) others as appropriate.

The contractor will be required to perform the following services in pursuing the evaluation:

1. Gather, organize and evaluate data about each of the programs described in 19.A. above;
2. Determine whether procedures of the contractor, A.I.D., the participating African governments and the American universities have been appropriate and/or effective in meeting the goals of the programs;
3. Determine whether the program outputs have satisfactorily addressed the major objectives of the programs as defined in the subsections under 19.A. above;
4. Determine whether the INTERAF program is an effective and satisfactory substitute for the ASPAU program;
5. Dependent upon the results of the evaluation, make recommendations as follows:

a. With reference to ASPAU, how successful has the program been in terms of its stated objectives and what lessons have been learned relevant to AFGRAD, INTERAF and other scholarship programs?
