The estimated budget for the 1978-79 program is \$2,758,358; subtracting from that amount the sum of \$508,080.66 (anticipated balance of unexpended funds which will be remaining in the FRLC as of 9/30/78), the estimated funding needed for the program will be \$2,250,277.34. The remaining amount of \$674,823.61 from the \$2,925,000 should be added to the Grant to provide partial funding for approximately 244 students who will be continuing their academic programs during the 1979-80 academic year. An additional 150 new student starts are anticipated to begin academic programs. The additional funding needed to finance the students in the 1979-80 academic year is expected to be provided to the Grant from FY 1979 funds, subject to their availability.

It is estimated that \$8,700 is the average yearly cost for a regular AID sponsored student under terms of this Grant.
