Subject: Grant AID/pna-G-1131  
Amendment No. 26

Dear Dr. Weintraub:

Pursuant to the authority contained in the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, as amended, the subject Grant is hereby amended to provide an additional \$13,625,348, together with an in-kind contribution of approximately 12,800,000 monthly cycles of oral contraceptives and 31,500,000 condoms, for the continuation of family planning activities as more fully described in Attachment A to this Grant, entitled "Program Description."

The total cumulative obligation of funds under this Grant is now \$51,538,188 and shall be available to finance commitments made by the Grantee in furtherance of program objectives during the period October 1, 1975 through December 31, 1980.

A.I.D.'s total cumulative "in-kind" contribution of contraceptive commodities is approximately 84,911,800 cycles of oral contraceptives and 439,104,300 condoms in furtherance of program objectives during the period October 1, 1975 through December 31, 1980.

The Grant is further amended as follows:

1. Attachment A, Program Description, Item I, Special Provisions, paragraph 3 - Add the following statement:

"The Grantee shall maintain status reports for subgrant audits for each project year which reflects the date the audit is requested, and the date it is received. A control will be established which shows disposition of subgrant audit results."

2. Under Attachment A, "Program Description," Item E. Staffing, paragraph 3 - Delete in its entirety and substitute in lieu thereof, the following:

"3. A total of 31 full-time and 2 part-time professional staff positions are authorized. FPIA will provide the AID Project Manager with a staffing chart, job titles, and job descriptions. Changes in titles, and/or functions will be accomplished through an exchange of letters between the AID Grant Officer and the FPIA Project Director. Any increase in the number of professional staff positions will require a formal Grant amendment. Major FPIA staff positions are currently as follows:

- (a) Chief Operating Officer/Project Director/PPFA Vice President for International Programs
- (b) Deputy Chief Operating Officer/Deputy Director for International Programs
- (c) Director of Grant Management
- (d) Director of Logistical Services
- (e) Director of Special Projects
- (f) Regional Directors

In addition, funds are provided in this Grant for 50 person-months per year of other professional services (including statistical, administrative and computer programming services) at the Grantee's New York headquarters office."

3. Under Attachment A, "Program Description," Item J, Budget, delete the existing budget in its entirety and substitute in lieu thereof, the following:



The aforementioned line items may, however, be increased in value as necessary by reducing the value of other budget line item

Except as expressly amended herein, the subject Grant, as previously amended, is in all respects ratified, confirmed and continued in full force and effect in accordance with its terms.



ASSURANCE OF COMPLIANCE WITH THE AGENCY FOR  
INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT REGULATION UNDER TITLE VI  
OF THE CIVIL RIGHTS ACT OF 1964


HEREBY AGREES THAT it will comply with title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (P.L. 88-352) and all requirements imposed by or pursuant to the Regulation of the Agency for International Development (22 CFR Part 209, 30 FR 317) issued pursuant to that title, to the end that, in accordance with title VI of that Act and the Regulation, no person in the United States shall, on the ground of race, color, religion, sex or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under and program or activity for which the Grantee receives Federal financial assistance from the Agency; and HEREBY GIVES ASSURANCE THAT it will immediately take any measures necessary to effectuate this agreement.

If any real property or structure thereon is provided or improved with the aid of Federal financial assistance extended to the Grantee by the Agency, this assurance shall obligate the Grantee, or in the case of any transfer of such property, any transferee, for the period during which the real property or structure is used for a purpose for which the Federal financial assistance is extended or for another purpose involving the provision of similar services or benefits. If any personal property is so provided, this assurance shall obligate the Grantee for the period during which it retains ownership or possession of the property. In all other cases, this assurance shall obligate the Grantee for the period during which the Federal financial assistance is extended to it by the Agency.

THIS ASSURANCE is given in consideration of and for the purpose of obtaining any and all Federal grants, loans, contracts, property, discounts or other Federal financial assistance extended after the date hereof to the Grantee by the Agency, including installment payments after such date on account of applications for Federal financial assistance which were approved before such date. The Grantee recognizes and agrees that such Federal financial assistance will be extended in reliance on the representations and agreements made in this assurance, and that the United States shall have the right to seek judicial enforcement of this assurance. This assurance is binding on the Grantee, its successors, transferees, and assignees, and the person or persons whose signatures appear below are authorized to sign this assurance on behalf of the Grantee.
