ACTION MEMORANDUM FOR THE ASSISTANT ADMINISTRATOR, BUREAU FOR  
POPULATION AND HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE

Problem: In order to successfully complete all activities initiated under the institutional development project, Population Dynamics in Asia and the Pacific (Project 932-0200) with the East-West Population Institute, a six-month extension from October 1, 1977 until March 31, 1978 is necessary. To do this, your approval is required and requested.

Discussion: The East-West Population Institute serves as the regional population center for individuals and institutions from the Asian and Pacific region involved in seeking solutions to population problems affecting their countries. The East-West Center, of which the East-West Population Institute is a part, is largely financed by State Department appropriated funds as well as contributions from Asian/Pacific governments. AID's support has been directed toward developing the institutional capabilities of the East-West Population Institute to provide training and technical assistance to the developing countries in the Asian and Pacific region.

Your authorization for funding for the period October 1, 1977 to March 31, 1978 will provide for the following activities:

1. Complete plans for development of Census Data Analysis Package (own children software and supporting data analysis). Target to be met by January 1, 1978. Costs for computer time and programming services \$ 30,000
2. Complete work resulting in workshop on World Fertility Asia/Pacific Survey. Completion date November 1977. Costs for participant travel, per diem and support services \$ 62,000
3. Finish analytical report on Indonesian World Fertility Survey by March 31, 1978. Costs for analysis, writing and publication \$ 50,000
4. Convene working group on Computer Editing and Imputation. January - March 1978. Costs for internship, travel, per diem, support services and computer time \$ 75,500


- 5. Complete development phase of Census Editing and Imputation Package by March 31, 1978.  
Costs for computer time and programming services \$ 49,000
  - 6. Conduct Asian/Pacific Census Conference, February 1978 for one week. Costs for participant travel, per diem and support services \$ 64,000
  - 7. Complete study on Comparative Fertility Transition in Asia, March 1978. Costs for participant travel, per diem and support services \$ 41,000
  - 8. Complete work on Vital Registration Systems in Asia, January - March 1978. Costs for participant travel, internships, support services and computer time \$ 75,500
- TOTAL COSTS \$447,000

The sources of funds for the total budget of \$447,000 for the period October 1, 1977 through March 31, 1978 are obligations of \$390,000 of FY 1977 funds and pipeline funds of \$57,000.

The activities to be completed represent a transitional period from an institutional building grant (AID/pha-C-1053) to a follow-on project (Project 932-0648) which will utilize the institutional capabilities developed under the grant to provide specific technical assistance and training activities to the Asian and Pacific developing countries.

We anticipate that the development and review of the new project paper will take place during the proposed six-month extension thus providing continuity between the terminating grant and the new contract.

Recommendations: That you authorize the six-month extension of this project until March 31, 1978 and sign the attached PROP Revision.
