## Project Authorization

Name of Country/Entity: Interregional  
Name of Project: Employment and Enterprise Policy Analysis Project  
Number of Project: 936-5426

1. Pursuant to Sections 103 and 106 of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, as amended, I hereby authorize the Employment and Enterprise Policy Analysis Project, involving planned obligations of not to exceed \$1,250,000 in grant funds from each account, totalling \$2,500,000 over a five year period from date of authorization, subject to the availability of funds in accordance with the AID OYB/allotment process, to help in financing local currency and foreign exchange costs for the project. It is further anticipated that \$4,920,000 of appropriated funds and \$400,000 in local currencies will be obligated by AID field missions and regional bureaus in connection with this project.


2. The purpose of the project is to provide USAID missions and LDC institutions with effective approaches to increase employment and develop small/medium-scale enterprise. The project will provide the empirical basis and analysis for dealing effectively with employment generation as a policy issue, will build a U.S. capacity to provide assistance to LDCs using the research and analysis, and will service Mission needs for technical assistance in this area on both a short-term and long-term basis.

### 3. Source and Origin of Goods and Services


a. Each developing country where training or other assistance takes place under this project shall be deemed to be a cooperating country for the purpose of permitting local cost financing.

b. Goods and services financed by A.I.D. under the project shall, except for ocean shipping, have their source and origin in a cooperating country or in the United States except as A.I.D. may otherwise agree in writing.

c. Ocean shipping financed by A.I.D. under the project shall, except as A.I.D. may otherwise agree in writing, be financed only on flag vessels of the United States.

SUBJECT: Authorization of S&T/RD's Employment and Enterprise Policy Analysis Project

Discussion: S&T/RD's proposed project on Employment and Enterprise Policy Analysis was reviewed by the Technical Subcommittee on July 15, 1983. At that meeting the Subcommittee recommended unanimously that the project paper be forwarded to the HRSC for approval.

The project paper was reviewed and approved by the HRSC on August 1, 1983.

A contractor(s) scope of work (attached) was completed on January 26, 1984, for incorporation into a PIO/T and RFP. It too has been vetted with Technical Subcommittee members.
