

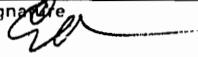

Overall evaluation confirmed that there has been a "leveling off" of family planning services acceptors due primarily to a lack of services in rural Tunisia and concluded, therefore, that GOT needs to modify and expand current national family planning program to increase service availability in rural areas. Specific areas requiring further attention are:</p> <p>a. Strengthening National Policy and Program Development.</p> <p>b. Improving Program Monitoring, Research and Evaluation.</p> <p>c. Developing a new family planning service delivery strategy for rural areas.</p> <p>d. Redesigning and expanding information, education and communication activities.</p> <p>2.
