**I. BACKGROUND**

Prior to 1965, the National Rehabilitation Institute (NRI), a semi-autonomous GVN agency, operated a single facility in Saigon where it provided limited care for the physically disabled people of Vietnam.

With assistance provided under a grant to the World Rehabilitation Fund (WRF) in 1965, the NRI has expanded its Saigon center through the establishment of vocational placement and medical rehabilitation facilities and augmentation of prosthesis manufacturing capacity. The NRI has also extended its services to Regional Rehabilitation Centers in Da Nang and Can Tho, constructed with US grant aid, and to Qui Nhon with the assistance of the Government of Canada. To meet the continuing and crucial needs in rehabilitation as an important aspect of assuring an economically viable population and to demonstrate continuing US and GVN concern for the longer range effects of the war, grant assistance to the NRI as a nucleus of Government of Vietnam physical rehabilitation activities will be continued.

**II. DESCRIPTION AND OBJECTIVES**

The objective of this project is the development of an effective rehabilitative capability in Vietnam which can provide to the severely disabled veterans and non-veterans the means of resuming an economically productive life. In order to consolidate gains made during the past three years, and to establish a firm and self-sustaining GVN capability in physical rehabilitation, assistance will be continued to the NRI, which serves as the coordinating nucleus for rehabilitative activities.

**A. Rehabilitative Medicine:** Development of a capability in the medical elements of rehabilitation; particularly at the physician level, commensurate with staffing needs of the National Rehabilitation Institute and its branches.

**B. Physical Therapy:**

1. Strengthening of the Physical Therapy Assistant School to assure graduation of 20 qualified physical therapy assistants per year.

2. Development of a training capability for physical therapy technicians, meeting the standards of the World Confederation for Physical Therapy.

**1. Rehabilitative Medicine**

**A. GVN Responsibilities**

(1) The NRI currently has assigned to it five GVN physicians; two at Saigon; and one each at Can Tho, Qui Nhon and Da Nang. To meet the crucial need for paraplegic and amputee rehabilitation the Ministry of Health and the Ministry of Defense agree to provide to the National Rehabilitation Institute additional physicians, one to be assigned to the Saigon Center and one each to the Centers at Da Nang, Can Tho, and Qui Nhon.

A Committee will be set up by the above organizations to provide technical supervision to these Rehabilitation Centers.

(2) The Ministry of Health agrees to make available one physician from each Regional hospital as well as selected provincial hospitals for two weeks training at NRI in amputation stump revision techniques.

**B. USAID Responsibilities**

(1) USAID will finance four months of post-graduate training in rehabilitation and especially in amputee stump revision for eight of these physicians after they have completed a six-month assignment to NRI. Upon return these physicians will be assigned by the concerned Ministries to training as well as clinical responsibilities at NRI.

(2) USAID agrees to provide four man-months of professional advisory assistance in rehabilitative medicine, particularly in aspects of in-service training for provincial hospital physicians.

**2. Physical Therapy**

**A. GVN Responsibilities**

(1) The Ministry of Veterans Affairs agrees to continue the Physical therapy assistant school at the Saigon NRI and to graduate twenty physical therapy assistants per year who will be qualified to work in Ministry of Health facilities.

(2) The Ministry of Health will initiate the establishment of a Civil Service category at the assistant level for trainees graduated from this school.

(3) The Ministry of Health will, in anticipation of NRI's plan to establish a technician-level school of physical therapy within the next three years, develop a curriculum which meets accreditation requirements of the World Confederation for Physical Therapy.

**B. USAID Responsibilities**

USAID will continue to provide advisory assistance to the physical therapy assistant school and in the development of a curriculum for the technician level school for physical therapy.

**3. Occupational Therapy**

**GVN Responsibilities**

The National Rehabilitation Institute agrees to inaugurate a training program in occupational therapy by assigning 4 trainees to the Qui Nhon Center for a 52-week period to work with Canadian technicians.

**4. Prostheses Manufacture**

**A. GVN Responsibilities**

(1) A total of 63 prosthetic-orthotic technicians are currently employed at NRI including the branch centers. The GVN (Ministry of War Veterans) agrees to assign an additional 20 technicians for training in prostheses manufacture.

(2) To assure that amputees are provided continual repair and maintenance service, the Ministry of Health and the Ministry of Defense agree to establish basic repair capabilities at selected provincial hospitals in areas of high-casualty incidence.

The Military Station Hospital prosthetic shops will be assigned to the Regional Rehabilitation Centers under the control of the Ministry of Health, the Ministry of Defense and the National Rehabilitation Institute Committee.

**B. USAID Responsibilities**

(1) USAID through WRF agrees to provide a highly-skilled prosthetist or orthotist on a consultant basis to development and monitor initial or in-service training programs on manufacture of prostheses. This technician will also provide consulting service to branch centers in organization and management of prostheses manufacturing units.

(2) USAID through WRF will assist in organization of the basic prostheses repair units described above and will provide minimal basic equipment.

b. Provide office space, utilities and custodial services for WRF advisors assigned to the project.

c. Make available to the WRF advisors, records necessary in the normal operation of the project.


This project was listed as terminating in the FY 71 P.B.S. As a result of the AID/W program review it was reinstated.



To meet the crucial need for paraplegic and amputee rehabilitation the Ministry of Health and the Ministry of Defense agree to provide to the National Rehabilitation Institute additional physicians, one to be assigned to the Saigon Center and one each to the Centers at Da Nang, Can Tho, and Qui Nhon.

A Committee will be set up by the above organizations to provide technical supervision to these Rehabilitation Centers.

(2) The Ministry of Health agrees to make available one physician from each Regional hospital as well as selected provincial hospitals for two weeks training at NRI in amputation stump revision techniques.

**b. USAID Responsibilities**

(1) USAID will finance four months of post-graduate training in rehabilitation and especially in amputee stump revision for eight of these physicians after they have completed a six-month assignment to NRI. Upon return these physicians will be assigned by the concerned Ministries to training as well as clinical responsibilities at NRI.

(2) USAID agrees to provide four man-months of professional advisory assistance in rehabilitative medicine, particularly in aspects of in-service training for provincial hospital physicians.

(3) USAID will finance four months of intensive training for 6 selected prosthetic-orthotic technicians in order that they may, in turn, train technician trainees in the Republic of Vietnam.

**2. Physical Therapy**

**a. GVN Responsibilities**

(1) The Ministry of Veterans Affairs agrees to continue the Physical therapy assistant school at the Saigon NRI and to graduate twenty physical therapy assistants per year who will be qualified to work in Ministry of Health facilities.

(2) The Ministry of Health will, in anticipation of NRI's plan to establish a technician-level school of physical therapy within the next three years, develop a curriculum which meets accreditation requirements of the World Confederation for Physical Therapy.

The Military Station Hospital prosthetic shops will be assigned to the Regional Rehabilitation Centers under the control of the Ministry of Health, the Ministry of Defense and the National Rehabilitation Institute Committee.

**b. USAID Responsibilities**

(1) USAID through WRF agrees to provide a highly-skilled prosthetist or orthotist on a consultant basis to develop and monitor initial or in-service training programs on manufacture of prostheses. This technician will also provide consulting service to branch centers in organization and management of prostheses manufacturing units.

**A. BACKGROUND**

Prior to 1965, the National Rehabilitation Institute (NRI), a semi-autonomous GVN agency, operated a single facility in Saigon where it provided limited care for the physically disabled people of Vietnam. With assistance provided under a grant to the World Rehabilitation Fund (WRF) in 1965, the NRI has expanded its Saigon center through the establishment of vocational placement and medical rehabilitation facilities and augmentation of prosthesis manufacturing capacity. The NRI has also extended its services to Regional Rehabilitation Centers in Da Nang and Can Tho, constructed with US grant aid, and to Qui Nhon with the assistance of the Government of Canada.

The NRI has developed to the point that the only remaining assistance provided by the grant is in the procurement of certain commodities, in-country training of personnel, and some budgetary assistance for technician salaries. Administrative services are handled exclusively by NRI and during this project year efforts will be directed toward a further transfer of commodity support to NRI and the development, with the cooperation and assistance of the Ministry of Health (MOH) of ten satellite centers. These centers are being developed to expand production and repair resources and to provide service to greater numbers of the affected population.

**B. GOAL STATEMENT**

To improve the quality of life and well being of the populace and to help increase per-capita production.

**C. PROJECT PURPOSE**

The NRI is responsible for providing a total staff of 520 persons of which 70 are technicians. The MOH will provide the staff for the ten provincial centers to consist of 10 persons trained in physical therapy and 40 persons trained in the construction and repair of orthotic/prosthetic devices.

b. Support Services

The NRI budget increased from VN\$138 million in CY 1971 to approximately VN\$200 million in CY 1972 to allow for the expansion of its own commodity procurement system. The GVN continues to provide Trust Fund support (committed during FY 72) for stipends and related supplies for in-country training programs, salary stipends to NRI employees, local contract employees, and for any needed reconstruction at the five provincial hospital centers.

c. Physical Facilities, etc.

The NRI provides for and maintains the National Rehabilitation Center, Saigon, and the Regional Branch Centers in Da Nang, Qui Nhon, and Can Tho. The Ministry of Health will provide facilities for the expansion of the program during FY 73 to the five provincial hospital centers at Thua Thien, Pleiku, Khanh Hoa, Long Khanh, and An Giang. The Ministry of Defense provides for and maintains the Military Rehabilitation Center at Cong Hoa Hospital, Gia Dinh.
