I. BACKGROUND

The USAID has been providing assistance to the National Technical Center (NTC) since July 1969 through a contract with the University of Missouri-Rolla, AID/VN-65. This assistance was based on a survey of engineering needs in Vietnam made in 1967 and 1968. The NTC is the only institution in Vietnam whose major purpose is to prepare engineers in four fields: electrical, mechanical, civil and chemical. In the modernization, industrial and economic development of Vietnam, the NTC has a major role in producing the skilled leadership and manpower needed in this process.

II. GOAL STATEMENT

The goal to which this project contributes directly is the development of a higher education system which produces effective high-level manpower with life-related competencies to assume leadership roles in the economic and social development of Vietnam. It also contributes directly to providing trained manpower for the agro-industrial development of the country.

III. PROJECT PURPOSE

The purpose of this project is to develop a quality engineering institution of collegiate level responsive to the engineering needs of Vietnam.

IV. CONDITIONS EXPECTED AT THE END OF PROJECT

1. An adequate, qualified, effective faculty and staff.
2. An improved, effective administrative organization and operation.
3. An adequate physical plant and facilities efficiently utilized and maintained.
4. The NTC established as a viable institution producing competent graduate engineers.
5. The NTC with graduate work started in selected areas.

Explanation and/or comments

The purpose of this Revision is provide financing for the extensions of 3 participants now in training in the US.

The name of this subproject has been changed to the National **Technological Institute** from the National Technical Center in accordance with the name change at the institution. The new name is indicated in this documentation and will be used in all future references to this subproject.

The attached PIO/P for Mr. Luu Huu Dung changes his training program from non-degree academic to Ph. D. in Hydraulic Engineering. When Mr. Dung first left for training he was the only instructor in his field at the institution and he could not be spared for enough time to complete a Doctorate although that was the preferred end to his training. Since he has been in school another professor of hydraulics, trained in France, has begun teaching at the Institute. Now Mr. Dung has the time to complete a Ph. D. program before returning. The NIT and USAID/ED have reviewed his situation and feel it is highly desirable that he continue for that degree.

The attached waiver permits subobligation of \$15,000 for the extension of 3 participants - 1 Masters and 1 Ph. D. - now studying in the US to be completed expeditiously when the subobligating documents are prepared.

The purpose of this Project Agreement (ProAg) is to commit CY 1973 AAC funds as outlined in the GVN National Budget for CY 1973, Title 34 (American Aid Programs) and, within Title 34, under Sub-title 18 (Ministry of Education), Chapter 614 (Higher Education), Project No. 660-367.

This ProAg was previously circulated indicating a transfer of VN\$10,000,000 to USAID to be held as Funds-in-Trust to be expended through the contract with the University of Missouri (Rolla). This approach was not approved by the Ministry of Education for the reasons stated in letter No. 8270/VHGDTN/NGV1 addressed to Dr. Mary Neville and dated 11/29/73 (attached). The previous ProAg committing these funds is therefore cancelled and this documentation replaces it.

H. REPORTING AND EVALUATION

The US and GVN Project Managers will prepare jointly an annual evaluation of the project based on criteria set forth in this agreement.


