I. BACKGROUND

On October 6, 1969, the President of the Republic of Vietnam, in his address to the National Assembly, outlined long-range social and economic goals for the Vietnamese school system--"Mass, practical education at the elementary level in the spirit of community education, and of the comprehensive high school at the secondary level." It was determined that the traditional colonial education system, with its outmoded curriculum, teaching methods, and school organization based upon the concept of eliminating the less academically inclined through increasingly difficult examinations cannot achieve those goals. It is to be replaced by a one-through-twelve-grade continuous program of "useful" education for all children living in a democratic society.

The present teacher education program is carried out within a complex framework which often is characterized by duplication of effort and/or elements which are in conflict with other elements of the program. Elementary teachers are prepared in two-year normal schools; secondary teachers pursue a three-year program in the Faculties of Pedagogy of the universities after completion of a basic year in the Faculty of Letters or Faculty of Science; agriculture teachers are trained in the Directorate of Agricultural Education; and technical/vocational teachers are produced through the technical institutes. There is little coordination between these separate institutions. Each has different entrance requirements and graduates hold different degrees of status with respect to academic prestige and civil service placement.

The Ministry of Education now has the trained manpower within the country to develop the kinds of teacher education programs which will produce well-prepared teachers in sufficient numbers to staff all types of schools. It must utilize these resources now in planning and implementing a full-scale, coordinated, four-year, quality teacher education program and a graduate school of education.

II. OBJECTIVE

Revise the teacher education program in order to produce in-country a sufficient number of well qualified teachers, school administrators, school supervisors, and other personnel to continually evaluate, plan, and carry out sound education programs which will provide trained manpower needed in social and economic development.

It is planned to mobilize immediately the in-country resources mentioned above and to focus upon an analysis of the teacher education program, with the aim of determining appropriate changes, and making specific recommendations for change to the Ministry of Education. This will be carried out as follows:

A. The Commission on Teacher Education and Standards. The Ministry of Education will establish the commission early in FY71, drawing upon professionally prepared manpower resources in-country, including returned participants from the United States and third countries. The Commission will be responsible for studying the needs of the education system and defining the overall structure, content, operational procedures, and standards of a coordinated, quality teacher education program and for recommending to the Ministry of Education a plan for implementing a revised and unified program in the teacher education institutions, and submitting its findings by December 31, 1971.

B. Task Forces. The Commission will function through four task forces as follows:

1. The Minimum Standards Task Force will recommend desirable and realistic minimum standards in requirements for entrance to teacher education programs, length of programs, graduation requirements, and qualifications of instructional and administrative staffs.

2. The Curriculum Task Force will specify the general and professional courses needed by all teachers as well as the special courses for teaching fields such as elementary and secondary general education, agricultural education, home economics, industrial arts education, science, mathematics, business education, language arts, and social studies.

3. The Course-Credit Accountability Task Force will design a system of course-credit accountability to help equalize quality programs and to upgrade sub-standard teachers, to enable transfer of study from one field of preparation to that of another field without loss of time.

4. The Graduate Education Program Task Force will design graduate education programs for classroom teachers, instructional supervisors and school administrators.

The dollars obligated herein will provide funding for hand and agricultural tools, sewing machines, and typewriters for use in the teacher education program of the normal schools.

VI. REPORTING AND EVALUATION

The USAID and MOE Activity Managers shall prepare jointly and submit to their respective agencies semi-annual and other reports as deemed necessary in a format acceptable to both governments. These reports will cover progress in attainment of specific targets and identify any problems or delays encountered which are deterring progress of the activity.

The GVN/MOE assigns highest priority to teacher education to: (1) Meet quantitative needs at every level, as enrollments increase in elementary, secondary and higher education and (2) give pre-service and in-service preparation which will enable teachers to revise and modernize classroom programs in keeping with GVN/MOE goals for education.

The FY71 ProAg for the Teacher Education Activity provided advisory service and funding for the creation of a Ministry of Education Commission on Teacher Education. During CY71 five task forces under the coordination of this Commission studied needs of Vietnamese teachers and changes which must take place in teacher education programs to improve the quality of preparation as well as to increase numbers of teachers. Beginning in CY72 recommendations of these task forces related to curriculum revision, minimum standards for teacher education institutions and programs, course-credit accountability system and advanced or graduate level study programs are to be implemented.

Development of a professional leadership group within the Ministry of Education and the teacher education institutions has been and continues to be a MOE objective. Membership on the Commission and in the task forces has provided practical experience in educational leadership. Implementation of the recommendations of the task forces is another step in leadership development. This implementation with continuous evaluation will be of longer duration than this ProAg; however, through the ProAg initial guidance in implementation will be provided to strengthen developing leadership skills.

II. OBJECTIVE

Begin implementation of recommendations made by the task forces of the Teacher Education Commission to enable the teacher education institutions to: (1) increase the number of elementary and secondary teachers; (2) improve the quality of their preparation, and (3) develop a blue-print for advanced level preparation of professional teacher educators.

One USAID direct-hire library development advisor will work with counterparts in the Ministry of Cultural Affairs as well as in the MOE and will coordinate with Asia Foundation and USIS (JUSPAO) in development of a national library system which includes the National Library, university and school libraries.

Research provided for in this activity is related to the studies of the Commission on Teacher Education; and conferences or seminars for the general improvement of teacher education will be the responsibility of the coordinating committee of the Commission.

In the American Aid Chapter Budget for Teacher Education, which is incorporated into this ProAg, details of courses, seminars, and special programs in teacher education are given, with the funding required. These constitute the work plan for the activity, with the in-service training courses, workshops, etc., scheduled for the summer months. The work of the Commission, the library development activity and technical advisory assistance extends through the calendar year. Piaster funding supports the work plan on a calendar-year basis.



Attached is "Master" ProAg and supporting AAC budget for Higher Education (Teacher Education sub-project 367.03). The regular AAC budget of VN\$117 million is in accordance with agreement reached with DGBFA at the time of the September 1971 review sessions. The VN\$117 million consists of VN\$109 million specifically identified for teacher education/training and VN\$8 million for Higher Education Workshops (VN\$3 million) and Library Development at Hue University (VN\$5 million), with the VN\$8 million activities actually being an integral part of the total teacher education program. The AAC Reserve budget of VN\$32 million has been incorporated into the total budget and is required for activities in accelerated practical arts teacher training, vocational teacher training and agricultural teacher training. The Reserve funding also has been agreed to in terms of priorities identified in the February 1972 meeting with DGBFA on total CY 1972 Reserve availabilities and requirements.

A. BACKGROUND

The GVN/MOE continues to assign high priority to teacher education in order to: (1) meet quantitative and qualitative needs at every level as enrollments increase in elementary, secondary and higher education, (2) give pre-service preparation which will enable teachers to revise and modernize classroom programs in keeping with GVN/MOE goals for education, (3) develop graduate programs to prepare teachers and professors for new and developing institutions, and (4) meet the needs of veterans, handicapped civilians and displaced persons as a part of the total rehabilitation and reconstruction program for the development of Vietnam.

The FY 71 ProAg for the Teacher Education Activity provided advisory services and funding for the creation of a Ministry of Education Commission on Teacher Education. During CY 71 and 72 five task forces under the coordination of this Commission studied the needs of Vietnamese teachers and changes which must take place in teacher education programs to improve the quality of preparation as well as to increase numbers of teachers. Beginning in CY 73 recommendations of these task forces are being implemented in such areas as curriculum revision, minimum standards for teacher education institutions and programs, course-credit accountability system and advanced or graduate level study programs.

Development of a professional leadership group within the Ministry of Education and the teacher education institutions has been and continues to be a MOE objective. Membership on the Commission and in the task forces has provided practical experience in educational leadership. Implementation of the recommendations of the task forces is another step in leadership development. This implementation with continuous evaluation will be of longer duration than this ProAg; however, through the ProAg, initial guidance in implementation will be provided to strengthen developing leadership skills with particular emphasis on the improvement and development of graduate level study programs in Teacher Education.

B. GOAL STATEMENT


