I. BACKGROUND

Rapid expansion of the educational system of Vietnam has been the basic objective of the GVN. Since 1954 the staff of the Ministry of Education (hereinafter referred to as the Ministry) has expanded from 9,800 to 75,100 and total public sector enrollment has increased from 355,000 to 2,575,000.

This massive expansion forced the GVN/Ministry and USAID to allocate human and material resources in the areas essential to rapidly expanding enrollment. As a result programs were implemented that emphasized increasing the supply of teachers, classrooms and instructional aids. The areas of planning, statistics, analysis and evaluation, research, finance, personnel and administration have received inadequate attention.

This educational planning and administration project was initiated in July of 1970 to correct the imbalances in the system. The first six months were devoted to joint project planning. During the second six months a twenty-two man Ministry Commission on Planning, Administration and Research looked into the problems of the Ministry. The Commission was assisted in its endeavors by USAID funded short-term consultants, two in Planning and one in Management. Two reports were published, the Consultants Report in June of 1971, which dealt with the general long-range operational problems of the Ministry and the Commission Report in July of 1971 which dealt with the Ministry's immediate operational problems.

During the third six months of the project and in line with the recommendations in these reports the Ministry reorganized the Directorate of Planning and established a Management Analysis Unit.

II. GOAL STATEMENT

The goal to which this project contributes is the development of an educational system which produces effective manpower with life related competencies to assume leadership roles in the economic and social development of Vietnam.

III. PROJECT PURPOSE

The purpose of this project is to develop a capability within the Ministry to efficiently plan and implement a balanced educational program.

2. A Management Analysis Unit with a trained staff which can carry out studies and make recommendations for improving the administration of the Ministry.
3. An Educational Research Unit which can conduct the types of investigation and analysis necessary to support realistic and effective educational planning.

V. FISCAL YEAR 1972 OUTPUT TARGETS

1. Publication of the Final Report of the MOE Commission on Planning Administration and Research in July 1971.
2. The Directorate of Planning and Legislation reorganized in October 1971.
3. Draft of four-year Educational Development Plan to be published by Planning Unit. (First draft in December 1971 and final draft in September 1972).
4. The Management Analysis Unit established in December 1971. The unit will have a ten-man staff by June 1972. Four trained in a five-month US training program and six in a three-month in-country program. In December 1971 five people will have completed their training (two in the US and three in country). The other five will have completed their training by June 1972.
5. Surveys of the Directorates of Examinations, Elementary, Secondary, Teacher and Private Education to be completed by the Management Analysis Unit by July 1972.
6. Draft of reorganization and decentralization plan for the MOE to be completed by the Management Analysis Unit by July 1972.

I. BACKGROUND

Rapid expansion of the educational system of Vietnam has been a basic objective of the GVN. Since 1954 the staff of the Ministry of Education (MOE) has expanded from 9,800 to 75,100 and total public sector enrollment has increased from 355,000 to 2,575,000.

This massive expansion forced the MOE and USAID to allocate human and material resources in the areas essential to rapidly expanding enrollment. As a result programs were implemented that emphasized increasing the supply of teachers, classrooms and instructional aids. The areas of planning, statistics, analysis and evaluation, research, finance, personnel and administration have received inadequate attention.

This Planning, Administration and Research Project was initiated in July 1970 to correct the imbalances in the system. The first six months (July-December 1970) were devoted to joint project planning. During the second six months (January-July 1971) a twenty-two man Ministry Commission on Planning, Administration and Research looked into the problems of the Ministry. The Commission was assisted in its endeavors by USAID-funded short-term consultants, two in Planning and one in Management. Two reports were published, the Consultants' Report which dealt with the general long-range operational problems of the Ministry and the Commission Report which dealt with the Ministry's immediate operational problems. During the third six months (July-December 1971) of the project, and in line with the recommendations in these reports, the Ministry reorganized the Directorate of Planning, established a Management Analysis Unit and prepared the first Draft of Vietnam's first four-year Educational Development Plan. During the fourth six months period (January-June 1972) the Ministry reorganized at the upper levels in preparation for a later reorganization at the lower levels, established a Center for Research, Collection and Publication of Educational Documents and finalized the four-year Educational Development Plan.

To develop a capability within the MOE to efficiently plan, evaluate and implement a balanced educational program.


