I. BACKGROUND

Since its establishment in 1968, the Central Logistic Agency (CLA) in a sense has been "feeling its way." With USAID/Logistics assistance, additional policy and procedures have been published, warehousing and storage areas have been consolidated, and a time phased scope of work has been developed to enable the CLA to become a fully operational organization capable of providing logistical support for all civil ministries and agencies of the GVN.

While the CLA is still in the formative and consolidation stages, it is necessary to continue advisory assistance to assure its ultimate success. During FY 72 - 73, with US technical assistance this project will continue to provide overall management of the logistics support services required for the US non-military assistance program, as well as overall supervision and coordination of the USAID input into the further development of the CLA; beginning with FY 73 the residual functions of the National Maintenance System, Warehousing and Distribution, Port Improvement, Procurement, and Finance and Personnel Management will be assumed by this project.

B. GOAL STATEMENT

The Logistics Sector Goal is to develop a GVN common logistics system to meet the extraordinary and essential civil requirements during wartime and capable of phasing into a rational post-war system. In furtherance of the purpose of the Logistics Technical Support project, personnel assigned to the project, in coordination with CLA, as appropriate, provide the following services:

1. Coordination of activities within the sector, with other Mission divisions, and with other US agencies. This action will ensure that the major branch thrusts are directed toward attainment of the Sector Goal.
2. Formulation and promulgation of policy guidance, provision of administrative service, and technical support to the sector as a whole.
3. Technical advice and guidance to Mission management in the Logistics field.
4. Overall supervision of consolidated and project procurement services, to include acquisitions through the excess property program.

C. PROJECT PURPOSE

To develop within the Government of Vietnam (GVN) an organization (Central Logistics Agency) capable of managing a common logistics system for the procurement, receipt, storage, distribution and maintenance of, and accounting for commodities of the types required in support of joint USAID/GVN projects and for GVN non-military requirements.

D. CONDITIONS EXPECTED AT THE END OF PROJECT

1. By the end of FY 75, it is expected that the Central Logistics Agency (CLA) will have completed its management and technician staffing and training, and the organization will be on a self-sustaining basis, operating efficiently, and capable of providing central logistical services to all GVN ministries and agencies. It is further expected that CLA will be operating under a sound and modern financial accounting system, that all GVN off-shore and local procurement will be centralized, that all GVN procurement of office supplies will be centralized.

2. In the area of transportation, warehousing, and distribution, it is envisioned that the need for a large complex of CIA and Ministry of Interior operated warehouses will have disappeared as a result of a massive reduction in common-use items, PL 480 Title II, and other project commodities. All GVN agencies will be serviced directly from the CIA-operated National Depot and a smaller depot located at Da Nang. Regions III and IV will be serviced directly from Saigon. The reduced imports of AID-financed and PL 480 commodities will eliminate the need for cargo arrival accounting and monitoring by USAID personnel, and this function will be performed by CIA and the Voluntary Agencies (VolAgs) who will arrange their own transportation, warehousing, and distribution. As a result of a post-hostilities situation, a reduced commodity input, and a reduced workload, the manpower and monetary constraints on CIA will have been eased and dependency on USAID for major assistance will have been eliminated.

3. By FY 75, GVN will have reduced the size of its vehicle fleet and disposed of old and uneconomically repairable equipment. Maintenance capability will have been increased at the national and provincial level as trained manpower becomes available from phased-down contractor operations and reduction of the military force. (RFD) will have a firmly established revolving fund, supported by sufficient foreign exchange to ensure continued repair parts supply. By FY 75 also, the province maintenance shops will be operationally capable of supporting GVN vehicles and will have absorbed the smaller autonomous ministry shops. It is envisioned that these shops will be operated by the province government.

4. Procurement of USAID project commodities will have been drastically reduced by FY 74, and many projects now receiving technical assistance from USAID/Logistics in commodity procurement, receipt, distribution, and disposal will have been terminated. The Excess Property Program will be phased down. The bulk of acquisitions will have been received. The US Military as a source for excess property will be "dried-up".

5. All technical assistance to port management will be completed by the end of FY 75.

6. Overall policy guidance to CLA in the area of transportation, commodity distribution, procurement, and maintenance will be required to the end of FY 75.

E. OUTPUT TARGETS

Training in applied management, financial management and procurement management for four participants funded and returned to Vietnam prior to FY 72 are now utilized by the CLA. One is a specialist in the Directorate of Supply Management; two are now the Director for Finance and Director of Procurement, respectively. One other is now the Chief, Repair Parts Service.

Ongoing training in the US is for three participants: one in financial management and two in supply management.

AID direct hire technicians have their primary responsibility relates to technical assistance to the CLA. The Assistant Director for Logistics, his deputy and an Assistant Program Officer coordinate and supervise the following:

a. Five supply management advisors in all activities relating to procurement of AID financial commodities of a non-military nature, including those implemented under PL 480 Title II.

b. Eight technicians who are assisting the CIA as the officially designated GVN agency having responsibility for various aspects of acquiring, rehabilitating, receiving, storing and distributing excess commodities available from the phase down of US military operations. Excess property is also, under certain conditions, made available to Voluntary Agencies. In addition these technicians coordinate the disposal of productive facilities, such as stone quarries, no longer required by the military.

F. INPUTS

1. The Government of Vietnam agrees to provide:

a. Personnel: CIA has approximately 216 personnel on board who are assigned to the Office of the Director General, and the Directorates of Administration and Finance, Plans and Training, and Procurement. These directorates are considered counterparts to the Logistics Technical Support project personnel. The numbers of personnel assigned to these directorates under the current organization appear adequate; however, there is a critical lack of expertise, capability, and adaptability on the part of some key personnel assigned to CIA.

b. Local Currency - Under the Logistics Technical Support project, plasters have been programmed through the American Aid Chapter (AAC) for the handling, transportation, and minor renovation of vehicles and equipment acquired through the situs-country excess property program, (See budget attached)

c. Physical facilities - Included as part of the resources available are a huge warehouse complex at Thu Duc (near Saigon), and smaller, similar installations at Da Nang and Nha Trang.

2. The United States Government agrees to provide:

Explanation and/or comments

The attached ProAg covers the technical assistance provided to the Central Logistics Agency (CLA) and makes provision for the coordination of the utilization of excess property as the first source of USAID-financed commodities.

The Director signed an action memorandum on March 10, 1971 agreeing in principle to the substitution of acceptable excess property for new procurement and the negotiation of a contract to clean and make minor repairs in the equipment to put it in acceptable condition.

A meeting was held in Logistics on March 18, 1971 at which it was decided to substitute excess property for a large number of vehicles and other equipment for which new procurement documentation had been initiated.

CY 1972 funding as contained in GVN Budget is proposed herein for the in-country movement and cleaning of this and other excess to follow as indicated below:

1. VN\$84,000,000 to cover handling and related service charges and
2. VN\$45,000,000 to contract for the cleaning, painting, minor repairing, required to put the excess property into acceptable condition.





BACKGROUND

The Saigon Commercial Port has obtained through the excess property program two large cranes which are barge mounted. It is planned to use these cranes for discharging and loading heavy lift from ships within the port. In addition it is planned to use these cranes in the initial phase of the planned container handling facility in the K-12 berth area. At a later date one of the cranes may be moved to Vung Tau to permit the loading/discharge of containers at that port facility.

These cranes are considerably more sophisticated than cranes previously available to the Saigon Commercial Port. To assure the proper operation and maintenance of this costly equipment (Est. approximately \$500,000) it is highly desirable to train the Port crane operators and maintenance personnel in proper procedures concerning this equipment.

The duties of such an operator would be to operate and also train the Saigon Port crane personnel in both the operation, care, and maintenance of these two pieces of equipment.

Prior to April 11, 1971 the management of the Danang and the Saigon Commercial Ports was the responsibility of the Directorate General of Port Authority while the management of the Nha Trang, Qui Nhon, Ba Ngoi, Vinh Long and Can Tho ports was the responsibility of the Directorate of Navigation. The purpose of this program documentation (ProAg Rev. & PIO/T) is to obligate and subobligate US\$112,000 and VN\$4,340,000 to finance completion of the Arthur Young, Inc. contract. This contract, undertaken in four phases to develop modern accounting and financial management systems for the GVN's Central Logistics Agency, was earlier thought to be adequately funded through Phase IV by two prior year PIO/Ts. The scopes of Phases III and IV, however, were dependent on Phase II and were not known until December, 1972. Since the scopes-of-work determined for Phases III and IV were greater than anticipated, the US\$100,827 and VN\$1,215,000 balances in prior year funds available in PIO/T 91-90844 (US\$65,032) and PIO/T 21-20421 (US\$35,795 and VN\$1,215,000) proved to be inadequate by US\$112,000 and VN\$4,340,000.

Although no funding was requested for these contract services in the PBS, funds to finance completion of Phases III and IV have been made available through several cross-project and cross-sector reprogramming adjustments. These adjustments were requested in ADCCA's memos dated January 17 and January 30, 1973 (attached) and approved by ADPROG's memos dated January 31 and February 12, 1973 (attached).

A. BACKGROUND

1. The USAID Logistics Technical Support Project has provided technical assistance to the Government of Vietnam (GVN) entities rendering logistical services essential to the orderly flow of goods and commodities to agencies of the GVN.

2. The primary types of logistical services receiving United States Government (USG) assistance and support included: (1) a nationwide port operation system; (b) a common logistics system for purchasing/requisitioning, receiving, storing, distributing and accounting for goods and commodities; and (c) a national warehousing and distribution system.

3. In addition, USG assistance has been provided to the following logistics related operations of GVN: a. a national maintenance system consisting of a Central Repair Parts Depot, a National Rebuild System, and the Province Maintenance Shops; b. a single unified system for processing USG excess property to the various GVN elements; and c. the commodity procurement system of the National Police Command, GVN.

4. With the passage of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1973 on December 17, 1973, USAID was required to terminate all forms of assistance to police and prison-related activities in Vietnam. As a result, all procurement action for police and prison-related commodities was suspended on January 11, 1974. Subsequently, all outstanding procurement actions, initiated prior to January 11, 1974, that were not shipped or under firm contract were cancelled. Upon joint AID and GVN review and determination, action was also taken to terminate support to the National Maintenance System, including the Central Repair Parts Depot and the Province Maintenance Shops.

5. Specific background information on the current residual activities (i.e., excluding above-mentioned terminated activities) under this project is as follows:

a. Directorate General of Commercial Ports (DGCP), Office of the Prime Minister.

(1) Prime Minister Decree #129/SL/Th.T/TWTC dated October 26, 1971, effected a reorganization of the then existing port operation system by consolidating the overall supervision of the port management and operation under the DGCP and designating two new commercial port directorates (i.e., a Da Nang Port Directorate and a Saigon Port Directorate).

The Da Nang Port Directorate was assigned operational control and responsibility for the commercial ports of Da Nang, Nha Trang, Qui Nhon and Ba Ngoi. The Saigon Port Directorate was assigned operational control and responsibility for the commercial ports of Saigon, Vinh Long and Can Tho. The above assignment is temporary pending complete reorganization of the port system.

(2) As an integral part of the GVN logistics complex, and at the request of the GVN, the USG began its support of DGCP to enable that organization to manage and operate an efficient nationwide port operation.

(3) Recent USG advisory assistance and support have been centered on: (a) developing the ports and port facilities; (b) establishing training programs for port personnel in the operation, maintenance and utilization of heavy equipment; and (c) monitoring the rehabilitation of excess property for port operation uses.

b. Central Logistics Agency (CLA), Office of the Prime Minister

(1) Prime Minister Decree No. 142/SL/Th.T/CS dated October 22, 1968 established the CLA to centralize the procurement and supply functions within the GVN.

(2) At the request of the GVN, USG assistance and support have been rendered to develop the capability of the CLA to: (a) manage and operate a common logistics system for GVN civil ministries and agencies; (b) manage and operate a national warehousing and distribution system; and, (c) process USG excess property (inspect, pick-up, repair, rehabilitate, store and deliver) for all GVN civil ministries and agencies.

(3) Recent USG advisory assistance and support have been focused in the following areas: (a) developing an orderly system of commodity procurement/requisitioning and delivery system; (b) maintaining a national warehousing and distribution system; (c) establishing a modern financial management and inventory accounting system for CLA; and, (d) processing US excess property acquisitions for all GVN sources.

B. GOAL STATEMENT
