### OBJECTIVES

The USAID program in South Africa focuses on leveling the playing field for historically disadvantaged individuals and on addressing the greatest challenges to South Africa--unemployment, HIV/AIDS, and crime.

### PROGRAM AREAS

**Democracy and Governance:** USAID is assisting with stemming the crime wave that surged after apartheid's authoritarian controls were lifted, establishing democratic local government, creating a tax structure that promotes the financial viability of the nonprofit sector, and reducing and prosecuting corruption.

**Education:** USAID supports the transformation of both the public school and higher education systems from an inferior and unequal education system to one offering quality learning conditions and programs through activities that develop specific skills and address institutional change.

**Health:** USAID works with South Africa to reduce the impact of HIV/AIDS and to improve primary health care services for all.

**Economic Policy and Trade Capacity:** USAID's program improves the capability of historically disadvantaged institutions and individuals to analyze economic problems and to design and implement market-based policies that reduce poverty and unemployment.

**Sustainable Employment:** USAID is helping South Africa to create sustainable employment by fostering the growth of small, medium, and micro enterprises owned by historically disadvantaged entrepreneurs.

**Housing and Environmental Services:** USAID addresses the lack of basic shelter, drinking water, sanitation, electricity, waste disposal, and safe and affordable transportation with cross-cutting local government service delivery activities to reach the fast-growing number of slum-dwellers in South Africa.
