Public Safety/Police Training

The purpose of this Project Agreement is to provide dollar funds for commodities in support of the Public Safety/Police Training Project during FY1970 and to increase the related Trust Fund Budget Contribution for CY1969.

A. Project Description

During 1968, the Government of Tunisia (GOT) requested assistance from the United States Government in equipping and training 1250 additional policemen to function primarily as a special crowd and riot control brigade and secondarily as an adjunct to the previously understaffed police forces in Tunisia.

In response to the request, the U.S. Government supplied such equipment as vehicles, radios, weapons and ammunition, tear gas and equipment and certain other police accessory items. It also provided the services of several U.S. Public Safety Advisors to carry out necessary training and to coordinate commodity utilization activities.

The special police unit consisting of two battalions and known as the Brigade de 1^{er} Ordre Publique (BOP) was established and all members received basic training in crowd and riot control tactics by the end of CY1968. All but several items of supplies and equipment were received and were in use by the close of FY1969.

B. Current Activities

The GOT now believes, and the U.S. Government agrees, that more advanced training in Civil Disturbance/Major Disaster planning and control is needed for members of the BOP, that training is needed for radio technicians who must maintain the FM radios furnished by the U.S. for BOP use, and that certain additional commodities are needed.

U.S. Contribution

To continue helping the GOT to bring the BOP to full operational readiness and capability, the U.S. Government agrees to finance, subject to the availability of funds, the following project inputs:

1. The ongoing services of one PSA generalist and one PSA/Regional Telecommunications Advisor.
2. Commodities for BOP use as per the attached PIO/Cs. (It is noted that the commodities shown on these PIO/Cs include items which are replacements for consumable goods initially provided, e.g. gas mask canisters, spotlight bulbs, and radio replacement parts. It is understood that in

the future the GOT will arrange to procure items of this kind from its own resources and under its own supply procedures.)

- 3. Participant training for up to four Tunisian police officers at a position grade of company commander or higher in the BOP, or police radio technicians.

C. GOT Contribution

To realize maximum benefits from the services of the two PSAs and other assistance provided by the U.S. Government, the GOT agrees to provide the following:

- a. Necessary budgetary support which will permit the BOP to operate at all times with maximum efficiency, not only during emergencies but also during normal deployment of forces and during training maneuvers.
- b. Approval for the battalion commanders of the BOP to establish a Standard Operations Procedures manual and a command post and to continue the necessary training program for members of the BOP, all of which are essential if the BOP expects to function effectively during emergency situations.
- c. Continue providing funds through the Trust Fund for local expenses of the two Public Safety Advisors presently in country, and for participant training costs, detailed as follows for CY1969:
