10 TIPS TO KEEP BIRD FLU OFF YOUR FARM

1 Do not buy, sell or accept any animals, eggs or manure from other farms.

2 Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water immediately after handling birds.

3 Confine your birds in an enclosed area, away from other animals or wild birds.

4 Clean farm and poultry equipment daily.

5 Burn or bury feathers and waste away from the farmhouse. Dig deep to bury waste and add lime so that scavengers do not dig it up.

6 Keep nose and mouth covered with a clean cloth, mask, or noseguard when cleaning, defeathering or slaughtering birds.

7 Clean your shoes, clothing, equipment and the wheels of any vehicle when coming back from farms or poultry markets.

8 Cover your hands with gloves or plastic when handling sick or dead birds.

9 Always change clothes after working on the farm.

10 Do not transport live or dead poultry from one place to another.
