And to act as a cyber tool, to enhance the communication between EISA and all the related agencies and public users




EISA Portal Objectives

2. Registration Module

This module is to act as an e-service tool to register and inquiry for registration requests for the different types of insurance intermediaries / agencies, such as:

- Actuaries
- Auditors
- Consultants
- Adjusters
- Brokers

3. Complain Module

This module is act as an e-service tool to submit or inquiry for a complaint against the different types of insurance intermediaries / agencies, such as:

- Insurance Intermediaries
- Private Fund
- Insurance Companies

4. Reports Submission Module

This module is a reporting tool to allow the Insurance Companies and Private Funds to submit the needed periodically reports to EISA.

This Module is secured by a username and password for each company or private fund.

Content Management Module

User Types

- **Viewer:** Read the portal contents, but can't make any modifications
- **Data Entry:** Insert and edit content limited to a certain scope. This modification will not be reflected to the online Portal until it passes the two levels of approvals.
- **Manager – Initial Approval:** Approves the data entry modifications – still need to have the final approval to be displayed on the online portal.
- **Deputy Chairman– Final Approval:** Approves the new modifications to be displayed on the online portal
- **Administrator:** IT role, to manage the system users and permissions.

6. Administration Module

This module main function is to control and manage the content management module users' permissions and privileges.

And to monitor and track the users modifications to the contents.



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
