AMENDMENT NUMBER ONE

THIS AMENDMENT is made between the Kingdom of Thailand ("Grantee") and the United States of America, acting through the Agency for International Development ("A.I.D.").

WHEREAS on September 20, 1984, the Parties hereto entered into a Project Grant Agreement for the Agricultural Technology Transfer Project ("the Agreement"), pursuant to which A.I.D. agreed to grant to the Grantee Five Hundred Thousand United States ("U.S.") Dollars (\$500,000), to finance certain foreign exchange and local currency costs of goods and services required for the Project; and

WHEREAS A.I.D. has agreed to provide an additional Five Hundred Thousand U.S. Dollars (\$500,000) in Grant funds;

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties agree that the Agreement shall be and hereby is amended as follows:

1. Section 3.1 of the Agreement is amended by deleting therefrom the words and number "Five Hundred Thousand United States ("U.S.") Dollars (\$500,000)", and substituting therefor the words and number "One Million United States ("U.S.") Dollars (\$1,000,000)".

2. Annex 2 (Project Grant Standard Provisions) to the Agreement is hereby deleted in its entirety and Annex 2 in the form attached hereto is substituted in lieu thereof.

Except as amended in accordance with the foregoing, the Agreement is ratified, confirmed and continued in full force and effect in accordance with its terms.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Kingdom of Thailand and the United States of America, each acting through its duly authorized representative, have caused this Agreement to be signed in their names and delivered as of the day and year first above written.
