

FORTIFIED FOOD PRODUCTS

Fortified food products are fortified milled flours and fortified flours blended with a protein fortifier (usually soy) as well as calorie and nutrient dense, ready-to-use foods. They are formulated to prevent and treat acute malnutrition in children, to prevent stunting and as meal replacements for children and adults in emergency situations.

Purpose	Provide nutritional boost to general ration, for school feeding, institutional feeding, safety net programs that are not targeted to children under 2, pregnant and lactating women (PLW) or malnourished children and adults.	Prevent stunting and acute malnutrition in children under 2, treat moderate acute malnutrition (MAM) in children between 2-5 years. Supplement traditional complementary foods for children between 6 months and 2 years. Provide nutritional support to PLWs.	Targeted to children between 6 months and 2 years to prevent stunting and acute malnutrition and treat MAM.	Treat MAM in children under 5. Each sachet contains 100 grams.	Treat severe acute malnutrition (SAM) in children under 5 and HIV infected adults. Each sachet contains 92 grams.	Provide a full day's supply of nutritional needs and calories for populations (6 months and older) on the move in emergencies. Each box contains 450 grams, divided into 9 portions.	Promote linear growth and appetite and prevent micronutrient deficiencies in children between 6 months and 2 years. Also a supplement for PLWs. Each serving contains 10-20 grams.
