


Feeding Central African Republic Refugees

Armed conflict and political instability in the Central African Republic (CAR) has **displaced over 436,000 people** and caused over **456,000 refugees** in neighboring countries since December 2013. Due to heightened insecurities over the past year, USAID’s Office of Food for Peace (FFP) supported the UN World Food Program (WFP) to expand its refugee food assistance operation in Cameroon, Chad, Democratic Republic of Congo, and Republic of Congo. FFP supports WFP in a variety of activities to **decrease food insecurity and malnutrition** among refugees from CAR, including general food distributions and targeted and supplementary feeding for pregnant and lactating women and young children.
