SCOPE OF WORK

19. Scope of Technical Services

A. Objective for which the Technical Services are to be Used Issuance of a report by the GOU Ministry of Education pertaining to desired form of expansion for nation's Primary Teacher Training schools.

B. Description

1. Two U.S. educators are requested to assist a GOU team composed of three (3) officials from the GOU Ministry of Education and one (1) from the Ministry of Planning to evaluate and present subsequent recommendations pertaining to the GOU's revised plan for requested U.S. assistance to build 10 new and to expand 13 existing PTTC's .

2. The study team will take into account applicable economic, financial, and social costs/benefits of the revised plan as compared to the previous plan which called for a proposed loan of approximately \$3.2 million to construct two regional PTTC's each with enrollments of 1000 students. This study will provide information of such scope and specificity to serve, if necessary, as a basis for proceeding with further planning including architecture and engineering work. The A&E aspects will include types of educational facilities to be included and space required, the feasibility of using standard plans at all sites, location of various buildings

1. The Contractor team will assist the GOU prepare a final report which is to cover in detail all the requirements outlined in the scope of work plus any other information deemed pertinent. The report is to present findings, conclusions and recommendations together with adequate supporting data and analysis. The report will be joint effort in keeping with the intent of this survey and should be prepared in draft form prior to the departure of the Contractor team from Uganda.

2. The Contractor team upon completion of its assignment and before departing from Uganda, will orally brief the USAID Director in Kampala on tentative findings, conclusions and recommendations related to this survey. This same information, together with a brief narrative discussion of survey activities reflecting the range of contacts, relations with GOU counterparts, problems for further study, etc., will also be prepared by the Contractor team in typewritten form and submitted to the USAID Director in Kampala (with a copy to AID/W) before its departure from Uganda.

3. The study will further address itself to the following problems:
- a. The GOU expectations as to the nature and kinds of primary education desired both at present and in the foreseeable future, including curricula, methods, educational approaches, relations with the schools and the communities they serve, and responsibility for and opportunities for education beyond the primary levels.
 - b. Numbers of new primary teachers and the required levels of training needed for the primary level educational system projected to 1980 by study of one or more sets of enrollment projections including the ratio and number of trained and untrained teachers by year during each enrollment projection period.
 - c. Analyze the sources of supply for entrants into teacher training at various levels and project the number of candidates expected to request, and be available for such training.
 - d. Determine number of instructors (tutors) required to adequately staff existing and new PTTC's to be constructed under the revised plans.
 - e. Estimate the capital and recurrent costs to the GOU of the primary teacher training program including a comparison of operating costs of the existing colleges to the operating/recurrent costs of the new and expanded colleges.
 - f. The evaluation of the revised GOU plan will consider the feasibility of the new plan of the GOU operating approximately 23 PTTC's, each with enrollment of 500 students, in terms of the availability of qualified students, availability of staff, availability of administrative and support personnel, and the availability of funds to finance the total program including an estimated cost per student of the revised plan as compared to the previous plan.
 - g. Recommend refinements or changes to the plan to permit achievement of teacher training objectives with maximum effectiveness at minimum costs including, but not limited to, anticipated enrollments, number, type, size, and provisions for projected needs for expansion taking into account such factors as particular language groupings within Uganda and long range development plans.
