The training will be provided in the fields of agriculture, business administration, education, engineering, nursing, pharmacy, public administration, public health preventative medicine and other fields which contribute to social and economic development as permitted under Section 211 of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, as amended, and as requested by the USAIDs in the Near East and South Asia and approved by the Regional Training Officer, AID/W, and appropriate university authorities.

For the current school year, the contract is funded on the basis of and not to exceed 485 enrolled.

Special Provisions

- A. Under this contract, AID will finance all direct and indirect fees for each participant. AID will also finance international travel, subsistence and incidental expenses for each participant under a PIO/P.
