Pursuant to Section 104 of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, as amended, the centrally funded program, Malaria Immunity and Vaccination Research, "Coordination for Malaria Vaccine Activities" was authorized on March 16, 1982. The Authorization is hereby amended as follows:

1. The life-of-project cost shall be increased by \$1,807,000. This raises the life-of-project authorization from \$732,000 to a new total of \$2,539,000. Contract duration remains the same.
2. The authorization cited above remains in force except as hereby amended.
3. This project is included in the FY 1982 Congressional Presentation (Annex 5, page 72).

ACTION MEMORANDUM FOR THE AGENCY DIRECTOR  
FOR HEALTH AND POPULATION

FROM: S&T/H, Clifford Pease, M.D. *CP*

Problem: Approval of a PAF amendment for the sub-project with the American Institute of Biological Sciences (AIBS) under Project 931-0453, Malaria Immunity and Vaccination Research.

Discussion: The amended PAF will allow the AIBS to sub-contract with the Instituto Nacional de Salud (INS) Bogota, Colombia, to conduct research.

The INS has submitted an unsolicited proposal for a three year extension of their research activity titled, Immunoprophylaxis of Malaria: The Search for Merozoite Immunogens. The INS research has been conducted for the past three years as a sub-contract under a prime contract with the University of New Mexico. We are planning to fund the next three years as a sub-contract under the AIBS contract because it will be less costly and easier to administer.

This project is a key element in the AID malaria vaccine network, especially the field testing of potential immunogens. We have discussed this proposed three year follow-on project with the staff of The American Embassy in Bogota at the recent LAC Health Officers Conference. They have been fully supportive of this project and have recommended that it be retained as a sub-contract in the AID Malaria Vaccine program.

The INS proposal was reviewed by the Agency's external review panel under the new research review procedures. Their comments are attached.

The committee agreed unanimously that the proposal was of high priority and should be funded. The reviewers also recommended that the project manager clarify two aspects of the proposal.

1. Under the past contract, sub-contract arrangement, both the INS and the University of New Mexico have developed a cooperative research relationship with the Max-Planck Institut. The reviewers wanted assurance that the Institut would continue collaborations with INS under the new contract arrangements. The attached letter from Dr. Heidrich indicates that the Institut plans to continue collaboration with both INS and the University of New Mexico.
2. The INS budget proposal includes \$40,000 for an automatic blood chemistry analyser. The reviewers questioned whether this equipment was needed at INS to serve the needs of the research network. The \$40,000 is included in this authorization but will not be included in the contract until the overall network needs can be determined.

Funds for the proposed activity are included in the FY 1982 Congressional Presentation and the FY 1982 OYB for the Office of Health.

Recommendation: That you sign the attached PAF amendment.
