I. Introduction and Summary

Funds provided under Grant AID/pha-G-1116 were made available for activities begun prior to 16 May 1983. This report includes narrative progress reports and financial information for each subaward, subcontract, or in-house activity supported under the Programmatic Grant in 1983. As in past years, the progress reports are presented by region and in-house activities (including subawards and subcontracts entered into as part of Council in-house activities under the Grant) and the summary of 1983 activities is divided into interregional activities, regional activities, and country-specific activities. In 1983, a total of 23 projects was active; 19 were started in prior years; 4 were started in 1983.

Interregional Activities

In 1983, interregional activities supported by the Programmatic Grant included contraceptive development and pre-introduction of advanced Copper-T IUDs.

In contraceptive development, support was initiated for comparative studies on the subdermal implant system of six capsules (NORPLANT^R) and the alternative system consisting of two covered rods (NORPLANT^R-2) at Rutgers Medical School and at the University of California, San Francisco General Hospital. Support was continued for animal toxicity studies being conducted at George Washington University and the Bowman Gray School of Medicine at Wake Forest University to prepare for a New Drug Application filing on the contraceptive vaginal ring.

Other contraceptive development activities supported in 1983 included a project on the effects of more than six months of daily intranasal LRH agonist treatment on ovulation in women; clinical pharmacology studies on contraceptive rings; comparative clinical studies to evaluate the effectiveness and safety of the levonorgestrel and TCu 380Ag IUDs; a study on the effect of levonorgestrel IUDs on rabbit endometrium using the New Zealand white rabbit as an experimental animal; laboratory and clinical evaluation of the potency and effects of LHRH-13 on ovulation in women; a project at the Worcester Foundation for Experimental Biology for the collection of ram rete testis fluid; and a project at the Salk Institute for Biological Studies for fractionation and purification of inhibin.

Support was continued for a Population Council in-house project to facilitate the wide availability and use of the advanced Copper-T intrauterine devices, Copper-T 380A and Copper-T 380Ag.

Regional Activities

In Sub-Saharan Africa, support was initiated for the Population Council in-house project, Design, Implementation and Evaluation of

Family Planning Projects in Sub-Saharan Africa to initiate discussion and to identify collaborative institutions interested in developing a post-partum family planning program and in expanding family planning information and services in Sub-Saharan Africa. In Latin America, support was continued for the Council's office located in Bogota, Colombia to monitor and provide technical assistance for AID-funded population activities in the Andean region, and for the Spanish Translation Program. In the Middle East, support was continued for the Population Council in-house project, Population and Analysis Techniques for Planners in the Middle East and publication of a monograph entitled The Population Factor in Development Planning in the Middle East. The monograph is expected to be completed and published by July 1984.

Country-Specific Activities

In Brazil, support was continued for Copper-T IUD Training and evaluation in medical schools. Support was also continued for a seminar on population projections at the Consejo Nacional de Poblacion and Instituto Nacional de Estadistica in Lima, Peru. The seminar was held in August 1983.

During 1983 project activities centered on evaluation and training more than the enrollment of new clinics.

Nevertheless, during the year, four new clinics were enrolled in the program, one each in the states of Sao Paulo and Rio de Janeiro and one each in Pernambuco and Goias. This brings the total number of participating clinics to twenty-eight.

To date, 21,607 IUDs have been delivered to CEMICAMP. Of this amount, 19,151 have been inserted; 8,615 were inserted during 1983.

The Ministry of Health has taken an increased interest in this project thereby causing the number of requests for training of physicians participating in the program to escalate. Twenty-six physicians were trained during this program year.

In addition, short term courses on IUDs and Contraception in Clinical Practice were given in several cities in Brazil.

It is expected that the final results from this project will be available after the first quarter of 1984.

AID funding for this period has been utilized to support the maintenance of the Population Council Bogota office covering rent, supplies, local staff support and computer time expenditures.

Professional staff have been supported through project specific funds. The Bogota office activities in Colombia have centered on:

- (1) completion of the third and final phase of the PROFAMILIA rural experimental CBD project
- (2) preparation of a proposal to determine the need to continue PROFAMILIA's family planning CBD program in distribution to be submitted to AID as an unsolicited proposal
- (3) continuation of the Spanish publications program with the Corporacion Centro Regional de Poblacion
- (4) preparation of a natural methods cost-effectiveness study to be funded by AID as a supplement to the new Programmatic Cooperative Agreement
- (5) completion of a Country Report on demographic, economic and social development in Colombia

For the Profamilia project, technical assistance has been given in project design, implementation, evaluation and report writing. In Peru, a seminar on population projections at the Consejo Nacional de Poblacion and Instituto Nacional de Estadistica was held during August. Also in Peru, Council staff provided assistance for the preparation of an evaluation of the organization and programs of the Instituto Peruano de Paternidad Responsable (INPPARES).

Purpose: To organize and conduct a study on the "Carcinogenicity of Estrogen-Progestin Combinations Delivered Intravaginally to Rabbits."

This is one of the two animal toxicity studies being conducted to prepare for a New Drug Application filing on the contraceptive vaginal ring. A group of rabbits have levonorgestrel/estradiol rings in place in the vagina and a second group has placebo rings. After 2 years, the animals are to be sacrificed and organs examined for evidence of adverse effects.

After two false starts attributable to poor quality animals in one instance and difficulty in keeping the rings in place in the second instance, the studies were initiated in September 1982 with 23 animals in the test group and 21 in the control. Five test and 6 control animals have died because of accumulation of hairballs in their stomach. A high fiber diet appears to have solved this problem. A pronounced decidual reaction has been noted in all test animals that have died.

The aim of this project was to study effects on bleeding patterns and on the endometrium and to identify any side effects associated with 12 month use of 200 and 400 µg/day of buserelin.

Twenty-two women entered the study; 17 continued for the planned duration of 12 months. Ovulation was regularly suppressed but with some luteal activity in 10 percent of cycles. Seven women had amenorrhea throughout the study. Thirty-six endometrial biopsies were studied. All showed atrophy or weak proliferative activity of the endometrium.

Purpose: To conduct clinical pharmacology studies on contraceptive vaginal rings.

The objectives of this project were to:

- a. Study ovarian activity, steroid blood levels, bleeding patterns and lipoprotein patterns in subjects using progesterone/estradiol containing rings.
- b. Study the effects of norethindrone/estradiol rings on lipoproteins.
- c. Study the effects of previous exposure to estradiol or levonorgestrel on estradiol absorption from the vagina.

The progesterone/estradiol rings were found to give inadequate control of bleeding patterns and not to regularly inhibit ovulation. The norethindrone/estradiol rings had moderate effects on lipoprotein patterns. Previous exposure to estradiol from estradiol/levonorgestrel rings resulted in lower estradiol blood levels than observed immediately after first use of an estradiol/levonorgestrel ring. The effect was not due to moderated release of estradiol from the ring.

Purpose: To continue studies on the effects of contraceptive steroids on atherogenesis, lipoprotein patterns, and general health using the cynomolgus monkey as an experimental animal.

After an initial 6 month acclimation period to a mildly atherogenic diet, treatment was begun with a levonorgestrel/estradiol ring, a placebo ring or Ovralk^R delivered orally. In addition the experiment included a group of male monkeys. Changes in lipoproteins were in the same direction as observed in humans using rings or Ovralk^R. After 2 years of treatment, the animals were sacrificed in January 1984. Tissues are being examined grossly and histologically with particular attention to coronary arteries and reproductive organs.

The NORPLANT^R system utilizes six capsules; NORPLANT^R-2 utilizes two covered rods. 175 subjects are to be enrolled on NORPLANT^R-2 implants and 75 on NORPLANT^R implants at this clinic.

As of January 1, 1984, 22 subjects had been enrolled at this clinic. The rate of enrollment is slower than expected, apparently due to a limited clientele and delays in making arrangements with other facilities to refer candidate subjects.

Seventeen persons, eleven from the Statistic Institute, two from the Lima Municipality and one each from the Ministries of Health, Education, Housing and Labor, participated in this program for mounting the Shorter and Pasta Population Projections computer package and were trained in its use.

Besides satisfactory mounting of the package, a standardized procedure was designed for package use in relation to data entry. Various "templates" were designed; they include the most general cases of population projection with initial population, fertility, mortality and migration, projection by single years, and socio-economic projections. Each time that a projection is made, a basic file is called and the necessary changes are made.

In addition, both detailed projections by single calendar year and labor force projections were carried out for Peru for the period 1980 through 2015. The present projections only give information for every five years between that same period.

Purpose: To initiate discussion and identify collaborating institutions interested in developing a post partum family planning program and in expanding family planning information and services in Sub-Saharan Africa.

During 1983, Dr. Virginia Laukaran attended a Reproductive Epidemiology Workshop for Anglophone Africa in Mombasa, Kenya, in cooperation with CDC/JHPIEGO and the National Family Welfare Center in Nairobi, for the purpose of discussing potential postpartum family planning programs. Dr. Laukaran provided technical assistance on project development to the Departments of Obstetrics and Gynecology of the University of Zimbabwe Medical School and the University Teaching Hospital in Lusaka, Zambia. Potential proposals were developed for postpartum family planning programs in Zambia, Zimbabwe, and Kenya. The Zambia proposal is pending until further technical assistance can be provided by Council staff in 1984. The Zimbabwe proposal has been reviewed and was referred to Family Health International for funding. In Kenya, a proposal was developed in the area of postpartum family planning taking into account the high prevalence of lactating women. This proposal remains under consideration by the National Family Welfare Center.

For the expansion of family planning information and services, the following activities were undertaken:

Rwanda: Technical assistance has been provided by Dr. Margaret McEvoy to the Office National de la Population du Ministère de la Santé (ONAPO) in setting up an ongoing monitoring and evaluation system for the 20 pilot rural clinics providing family planning services. A consultant, Maria Elena Casanova, developed and tested Information, Education and Communication (I.E.C.) materials for use among non-literate populations. A process to systematically review potential target populations for each of the pilot clinics has been set up; service statistic forms designed by Dr. McEvoy have been tested and reporting systems to measure the quality of information and ease of use have been modified according to need. Studies that will give rapid feedback to program managers on specific program components have been designed. A system to monitor the training, supervision, logistics, delivery of services follow-up of acceptors, information and education and outreach services has been developed. This project is ongoing.

Zimbabwe: Dr. McEvoy initiated discussions with the Child Spacing and Family Planning Association to assist the Government of Zimbabwe to design, test, and evaluate viable models of family planning service delivery systems that are acceptable at the community level in a variety of cultural contexts. The role of the family planning educator needs to be redefined and expanded in order to achieve nation-wide CBD coverage; a system of coordination of the multisectoral outreach workers needs to be instituted as well as the role each cadre will assume; I.E.C. materials need to be designed and tested, as well as supervision and monitoring systems; staff need to be trained in operation research methods. The final objective is to develop a cost-efficient CBD model which can be replicated on the national level.

Further development of this project planned for the summer of 1983 was delayed for political reasons. Additional follow up has been planned by Dr. McEvoy for the summer of 1984.


