Pursuant to the authority contained in the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, as amended, the United States Agency for International Development, (hereinafter referred to as "USAID"), under the Institutional Development Grants, agrees to grant the Private Agencies Collaborating Together, Inc., (hereinafter referred to as "Grantee:), under the terms of this Agreement, the amount of Baht 1,921,935 (Baht One Million, nine hundred twenty-one thousand, nine hundred thirty-five), not to exceed the Baht equivalent of US\$ 75,370 (exchange rate of US\$1 = Baht 25.50), to provide partial support for a one-year project titled "A Pilot Project in Korat Province for a Learning and Linkages Program for Sustainability" as more fully described in Attachment 1, "Program Description", to this Grant and Attachment 6, the Grantee's proposal dated September 1987.

The USAID contribution to the Project will be provided in increments, the initial one being made available in accordance with paragraph 1 of this Letter Grant. It is anticipated that the USAID overall contribution to the Project will be US\$ 140,530; provided, however, that subsequent increments beyond the one provided by this Grant will be subject to the availability of funds to USAID for this purpose, and to the mutual agreement of the parties, at the time of a subsequent increment, to proceed.

The effective date of this Grant is indicated under my signature below.

This Grant is made to the Grantee on condition that the funds will be administered in accordance with the terms and conditions as set forth in Attachment 1 entitled "Program Description", Attachment 2 entitled "Standard Provisions", and Attachment 4 entitled "Project Implementation Guidelines". In the event there is a discrepancy or disagreement between the Standard Provisions and the Program Description or Letter Grant Agreement, the Program Description and/or Letter Grant Agreement shall prevail.





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Program Description

A. Purpose of Grant

The purpose of this Grant is to provide support for A Pilot Project in the Korat Province for a Learning and Linkages Program for Sustainability, as more specifically described in Attachment 1 to this Grant entitled "Program Description."

B. Period of Grant

1. The effective date of this grant will be the date indicated below the signature of the USAID Director on the Letter Grant Agreement. The expiration date of this Grant is September 30, 1988.

2. Funds obligated hereunder are available for program expenditures between September 30, 1987 and September 30, 1988.

C. Amount of Grant and Payment

1. The total estimated amount of this Grant for the period shown in B.1 above is \$140,530.

2. AID hereby obligates the amount of \$75,370 for the program expenditures during the period set forth in B.2 above and as shown in the Financial Plan below.

3. Payment shall be made to the Grantee in accordance with procedures set forth in Attachment 2 Standard Provisions for U.S., Nongovernmental Grantees, entitled "Payment Periodic Advance."

4. Additional funds up to the total amount of the grant shown in C.1 above may be obligated by AID subject to the availability of funds, and to the Requirements of the Standard Provision of the Grant entitled "Revision of Grant Budget".

D. Financial Plan

The following is the financial plan for this Grant, including local cost financing items totalling Baht 1,953,300 (Baht One million, nine hundred fifty-three thousand, three hundred). E. Reporting and Evaluation

The Grantee will prepare and submit detailed progress report from the date of the Grant and such reports will become due within 30 days following the 6th, and 12th months of the project. Reports will describe the programs and problems of project activities as set forth in the Program Description, following the recommended reporting format (Attachment 3). The reporting of gender-segregated data on participants and beneficiaries of project activities is also required.

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An evaluation report will be due within 60 days following the 12th month (the terminal date of the project). The evaluation report will be in sufficient detail, including gender-segregated data, that USAID can judge the effectiveness of the project, the efficiency of implementing and the impact of project activities.
