Dear Mr. Stefanson:

Pursuant to the authority contained in the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, as amended, the Agency for International Development (hereinafter referred to as "AID" or "Grantor") hereby grants to the United Nations Development Program (hereinafter referred to as "UNDP" or "Grantee"), the sum of \$20,000 to meet logistic support costs for the CARICOM Disaster Relief Unit (CDRU) mobilized by the Pan Caribbean Disaster Preparedness and Prevention Project (PCDPPP) to coordinate relief operations carried out following the passage of Hurricane Hugo. This grant is extended to UNDP as the authorized regional representative of the U.N. Disaster Relief Organization, the Project Manager of PCDPPP.

This grant is effective September 19, 1989, and obligation made hereunder shall apply to expenditures made by Grantee in furtherance of program objectives during the period beginning with the effective date and ending December 30, 1989.



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SCHEDULE

A. Purpose of Grant

The purpose of this grant is to provide funds to cover logistic support costs for the CARICOM Disaster Relief Unit mobilized following the passage of Hurricane Hugo.

B. Period of Grant

The effective date of this Grant is September 19, 1989. The expiration date of this Grant is December 30, 1989.

C. Amount of Grant and Payment

1. AID hereby obligates the amount of \$20,000 for purposes of this Grant.

2. Payment shall be made to the Grantee in accordance with procedures set forth in Attachment 3 (the Standard Provisions).

D. Grant Budget

The following is the Grant Budget. Revisions to this Budget shall be made in accordance with the Standard Provisions of this Grant entitled "Revision of Grant Budget."

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Following the passage of Hurricane Hugo on September 16 and 17, PCDFPP with the assistance of the CARICOM Secretariat, mobilized a CARICOM Disaster Response Unit (CDRU) to coordinate logistics and operations and to provide critically required technical services. The CDRU made a significant contribution during the emergency phase of the relief work. The EEC provided funds to cover fuel costs for aircraft and vessels used by the CDRU. Funds to be provided under this grant will be used to cover a portion of the other direct costs incurred as a result of the CDRU's participation - accommodation, subsistence, telephone and transportation. Remaining costs will be met by the UNDP/UNDRO.

This Assistance is being provided pursuant to AID Handbook 8 which governs disaster relief activities carried out by the Agency for International Development for the United States Government.

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
