Dear Mr. Isavwa:

Pursuant to the authority contained in the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, as amended and the Grant and Cooperative Agreement Act of 1977, the United States Government, represented by the Agency for International Development (hereinafter referred to as "AID" or "Grantor") hereby amends this grant to The Regional Center for Services in Surveying, Mapping and Remote Sensing (RCSSMRS) (hereinafter referred to as "Grantee") by authorizing and providing additional funds for supplemental training.

The Grant is amended as follows:

I. ATTACHMENT 1, THE SCHEDULE, paragraph C. AMOUNT OF GRANT AND PAYMENT, Sub-paragraph 1, is deleted in it's entirety and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:

1. A.I.D. hereby obligates the amount of \$263,000 for program expenditures during the period set forth in B.1. above and as shown in the financial plan (Budget) below.

II. ATTACHMENT 1, THE SCHEDULE, paragraph D. BUDGET, is deleted in it's entirety and the following is substituted therefore.

1. The following is the Budget for the Grant, of which A.I.D. shall finance up to a maximum of \$263,000 of allowable costs (see Standard Provision of this Grant entitled "Allowable Costs"). A.I.D. shall not be liable for reimbursing the Grantee for any allowable costs in excess of \$263,000. Except as specified in the Standard Provision of this Grant entitled "Revision of Grant Budget", as shown in Attachment 3, the Grantee may adjust line item amounts within the grand total as may be reasonably necessary for the attainment of program objectives.

1/. No expenditures for purchase of automated data processing equipment will be eligible for reimbursement under this Grant without prior review and concurrence of the final procurement documents by the REDSO/ESA Regional Systems Analyst (see Section H).

III. ATTACHMENT 2, PROGRAM DESCRIPTION, section C. STATEMENT OF WORK, paragraph C.3.5. Training is deleted in its entirety and the following paragraph C.3.5. is substituted in lieu thereof. Also, the following paragraphs C.3.6., C.3.7., and C.3.8. are herewith incorporated into the Grant with full force and effect.

C.3.5 Training

RCSSMRS has a mandate to train African nationals from its area of interest in all aspects of remote sensing. The forefront of this technology is represented by the digital analysis of computer compatible tapes, which at present are not able to be analyzed at the Center because of limited computer power. The proposed personal computers and peripherals will overcome this difficulty, and will enable the center to provide more comprehensive training in the geographic information systems needed for food security planning in IGADD member states.

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The FAO early warning project has a specific mandate to train nationals from the participating countries in the use and interpretation of remote sensing data for famine early warning. The objective is to create self-sufficiency in the various national programs in interpretation of RCSSMRS outputs. The training program to be partially funded by this Grant will expose trainees to the equipment and methods used to obtain the products they receive. This training will include a general orientation for all trainees on the use and operation of the personal computers and peripherals purchased by this Grant. Selected nationals and RCSSMRS staff will receive specialized training in the operation and maintenance of the early warning project system as a whole.

C.3.6 Software Modification Consultancies and Data Purchase:

Key geographic information software (e.g. the IDA software developed for A.I.D.'s FEWS Project) will need to be modified by consultants to become more "user friendly" and therefore easier to use by IGADD, RCSSMRS and IGADD member states. Establishment of data archiving systems may also require consultant support. Funds may also be needed for the purchase of geographic information systems data.

C.3.7. Assistance to Ethiopia

Current A.I.D. policy prohibits use of A.I.D. project funds for activities in and of direct benefit to Ethiopia. Though Ethiopia is a member of IGADD, A.I.D. funds cannot be used to host activities in Ethiopia or to fund Ethiopian participation in IGADD activities. Ethiopian participants may, however, attend workshops or training activities sponsored by A.I.D. if their participation is funded by a non-A.I.D. source. The IGADD secretariat plans to use currently available non-A.I.D. funds for such purposes. As staff of an Inter-Governmental organization, participation by Ethiopians on staff within the IGADD Secretariat can, however, be funded by A.I.D.

C.3.8 Countries under Brooke and 620(q) at time of obligation:


Except as otherwise provided, member countries of IGADD are included in this project. As of the date of this Authorization, certain countries, including Sudan, are prohibited from receiving A.I.D.-financed assistance as a result of the Brooke-Alexander Amendment or Section 620(q) of the Foreign Assistance Act (collectively "Brooke"). None of

the funds obligated under this project by a particular obligation shall be provided for the recruitment of participants from, or for any other assistance to, any country that is subject to Brooke sanctions on the date of this obligation; except that such funding may be used for assistance to a particular country after the Brooke sanctions are no longer in effect in that country and IGADD is so notified by A.I.D. Ethiopia is prohibited from receiving assistance under other legislation.


